MAJOR CITIES:

POIPEY:

Poipet is a Cambodian town on the Cambodia/ Thailand border. It is a key crossing point between the two countries, and also extremely popular as a gambling destination as gambling is popular.

PHNOM PENH:

Phnom Penh is the capital and largest city of Cambodia. Located on the banks of the Mekong River, Phnom Penh has been the national capital since French colonization of



Cambodia, and has grown to become the nation's center of economic and industrial activities, as well as the center of security, politics, cultural heritage, and diplomacy of Cambodia. It was known as the "Pearl of Asia" in old days. It was considered one of the loveliest French-built cities in Indochina in the 1920s.

SIHANOUKVILLE:

Sihanoukville, also known as Kampong Saom, is a province of Cambodia on the Gulf of Thailand. It is a port city and growing urban center located 185 kilometres southwest of Phnom Penh which is the national capital. Sihanoukville's beaches are a popular tourist destination. Sihanoukville is also the location of the main production plant for Cambodia's national beer, Angkor Beer.

SIEM REAP:

The name Siem Reap literally means "Siam Defeated". It is the gateway to Angkor region. Its close proximity to the Angkor Wat temple complex has turned the city into one of the world's premier travel destinations.

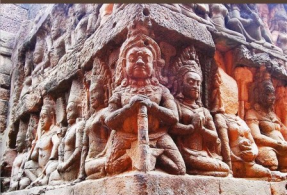
SIGHTSEEING OF SIEM REAP:

TEMPLES OF ANGKOR

ANGKOR WAT TEMPLE: The modern name, Angkor Wat, means "Temple City". Angkor Wat was first a Hindu, then subsequently, a Buddhist temple complex in Cambodia and the largest religious monument in the world. The temple was built in 12th Century by Suryavarman II. The temple is at the top of the high classical style of Khmer architecture. It has become a symbol of Cambodia and it is the country's prime attraction for visitors. It is the national symbol and the highlight of any visit to Cambodia. The UNESCO World Heritage Site of Angkor Wat is the primary draw for tourists. Scores of temples - some restored and some still overgrown with jungle vines - make up Angkor Wat which is about four miles north of Siem Reap.

ANGKOR THOM COMPLEX TEMPLE:

Angkor Thom, also known as Great City is a 3 sq. km. walled and moated royal city. It was the last capital of the Angkorian empire. It was the last and most enduring capital city of the Khmer empire. It was established in the late twelfth century by King Jayavarman VII. It covers an area of 9 km², within which are located several monuments from earlier eras as well as those established by Jayavarman and his successors. In this complex, there are different temples.



BAYON:

The Bayon is a well-known and richly decorated Khmer temple at Angkor in Cambodia. Built in the late 12th or early 13th century as the official state temple of the Mahayana Buddhist King Jayavarman VII, the Bayon stands at the centre of Jayavarman's capital, Angkor Thom. The Bayon's most distinctive feature is the multitude of serene and massive stone faces on the many towers which jut out from the upper terrace and cluster around its central peak.

TA PROHM:

Ta Prohm is the modern name of the temple at Angkor, Siem Reap Province, Cambodia, built in the Bayon style largely in the late 12th and early 13th centuries. It is located approximately 1 km east of Angkor Thom. It was

founded by the Khmer King Jayavarman VII as a Mahayana Buddhist monastery and university. Unlike most Angkorian temples, Ta Prohm has been left in much the same condition in which it was found: the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most popular temples with visitors. UNESCO inscribed Ta Prohm on the World Heritage List in 1992.

TA PROHM:

Ta Prohm is the modern name of the temple at Angkor, Siem Reap Province, Cambodia, built in the Bayon style largely in the late 12th and early 13th centuries. It is located approximately 1 km east of Angkor Thom. It was founded by the Khmer King Jayavarman VII as a Mahayana Buddhist monastery and university. BANTEAY SREI:

Banteay Srei is a 10th century temple dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. Banteay Srei is built largely of red sandstone. It lies near the hill of Phnom Dei, 25 km (16 mi) north-east of the main group of temples that once belonged to the medieval capitals of Yasodharapura and Angkor Thom. The buildings themselves are miniature in scale, unusually so when measured by the standards of Angkorian construction.

OTHER ATTRACTIONS:

ANGKOR NATIONAL MUSEUM:

The newly opened Angkor National Museum in Siem Reap promises eight chronologically ordered galleries of Angkorian-era artifacts and multi-media presentations of Angkorian history and culture.

THE TONLÉ SAP LAKE:

The Tonlé Sap means "Large Fresh Water River", but more commonly translated as "Great Lake" is a combined lake and river system of major importance to Cambodia. The Tonlé Sap is unusual for two reasons: its flow changes direction twice a year, and the portion that forms the lake expands and shrinks dramatically with the seasons. From November to May, Cambodia's dry season, the Tonlé Sap drains into the Mekong River at Phnom Penh. However, when the year's heavy rains begin in June, the Tonlé Sap backs up to form an enormous lake. There are several fishing villages and floating villages along the Tonlé Sap.

MECHREY BIRD SANCTUARY:

The Mechrey Bird Sanctuary has become one of the most important breeding grounds for endangered water birds in Southeast Asia. It is located in the marshes of Tonlé Sap Lake. This bird sanctuary provides a chance to tour by boat and see rare birds outside of captivity.

CAMBODIA FIT ITINERARY

SIEM REAP

3 NIGHTS/4DAYS

Day 1: Arrival at Poipet (Cambodia - Thailand Border Town) or Siem Reap International Airport. Welcome by our tour guide and transfer to check in hotel, refreshment. Later depart to visit the Angkor National Museum. (Time Permitting). In the Evening you can visit Night Market. (B)

Day 2: Early Morning, you can opt to visit SUNRISE at ANGKOR WAT TEMPLE. Back to hotel have breakfast. After having Breakfast depart to visit TA PROHM TEMPLE. It is one of the most popular attractions of Angkor as much of the jungle has not been cleared. And then to the crowning jewel of Khmer architecture, ANGKOR WAT TEMPLE is the national symbol and the highlight of any visit to Cambodia. Afternoon, BANTEAY SREI TEMPLE seemingly miniature in comparison to the other Angkor temples. It is considered to be the jewel of classical Khmer art. Built in pink sandstone, the walls are covered in exquisitely preserved carvings of unusual delicacy. And then The LAND MINE MUSEUM is run by Aki Ila, a former Khmer Rouge child soldier and landmine layer. (B)

Day 3: Today you can visit MEACHREY - One of natural tourism and mangroves for hundreds species of fresh water fishes and birds and decorated with ethnic stilted

houses line over the water surface up to the air. You will visit GREAT TONLE SAP LAKE which is habitat of many bird species it will bring you to meachrey. Afternoon visit ANGKOR THOM COMPLEX TEMPLE covers an area of 10 square km. Enclosed by a wall and wide moats, the city includes many of Angkor's most popular sights. Enter by the monumental SOUTH GATE OF ANGKOR THOM over a causeway lined on either side by statues of demons and gods, each carrying a giant naga. Continue to the TERRACE OF THE ELEPHANTS and the TERRACE OF THE LEPER KINGS, former spaces for public ceremonies, both adorned with dramatic bas reliefs. Visit the ruined BAPHUON, ROYAL ENCLOSURE and PHIMEANAKAS before continuing to the mysterious BAYON TEMPLE. In this temple, one of the most popular and compelling in Angkor, explore the galleries of beautifully preserved bas reliefs and ascend narrow stairs to reach the central sanctuary, where you will find giant stone faces smiling enigmatically down at you from every angle. (B)

Day 4: Breakfast at the Hotel. Today transfer to Bangkok border or Siam Reap Airport for your flight with wonderful memories of tour.

MAJOR CITIES:

HANOI:

Hanoi is the capital of Vietnam and the country's second largest city. From 1954 to 1976, it was the capital of North Vietnam, and it became the capital of a reunified Vietnam in 1976, after the North's victory in the Vietnam War. Vietnam's capital lies on the banks of the Red River, some 100 kilometres from its mouth. Hanoi is packed with museums, monuments, cafes, restaurants, discos, handicraft stores and almost anything that make your stay both convenient and entertaining.



HA LONG BAY:

Ha Long Bay, is approximately 1,500 square kilometers in North Vietnam, includes some 1,600 islands and islets, forming a spectacular seascape of limestone pillars. Halong translates as 'where the dragon descends into the sea'.

HO CHI MINH:

Ho Chi Minh City formerly named Saigon is the largest city in Vietnam. Ho Chi Minh City is located in the southeastern region of Vietnam.



HOI AN:

Graceful, historic Hoi An is Vietnam's most atmospheric and delightful town. A beautiful city, just south of Da Nang. The Old Town of Hoi An is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lounge bars, boutique hotels, travel agents and a glut of tailor shops are very much part of the scene here.



HUE:

The city is located in central Vietnam on the banks of the Perfume River, just a few miles inland from the South China Sea. Palaces and pagodas, tombs and temples, culture and cuisine, history and heartbreak – Hue is all about this. The city hosts a huge biennial arts festival, the Festival of Hue, in even-numbered years, featuring local and international artists and performers.



DA NANG:

Da Nang is one of the major port cities in Vietnam; the city is situated on the coast of the South China Sea, at the opening end of the Han River. Danang also makes a great base for day trips. The city is part of a long thin peninsula, at the northern tip of which is Nui Son Tra (called Monkey Mountain by US soldiers). China Beach and the five Marble Mountains lie southwest of the city.

Wondrous Halong Bay is truly one of the Vietnam's most impressive scenic sights. This exciting cruise will provide a fantastic view of the

scenery & some 3,000 limestones islands & islets rising amazingly. Later the afternoon, we drop the anchor for swim & enjoy the dinner on board.

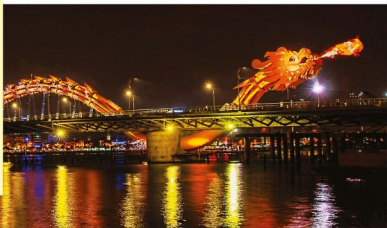

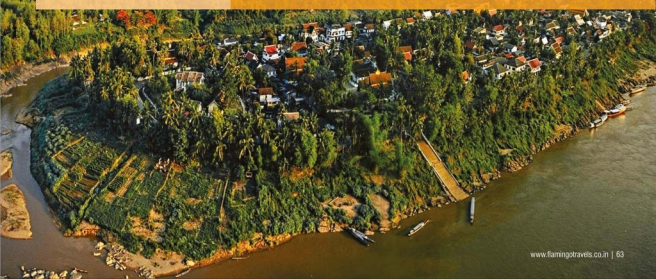
MAJOR CITIES:

In this temple, one of the most popular and compelling in Angkor, explore the galleries of beautifully preserved bas reliefs and ascend narrow stairs to reach the central sanctuary, where you will find giant stone faces smiling enigmatically down at you from every angle. 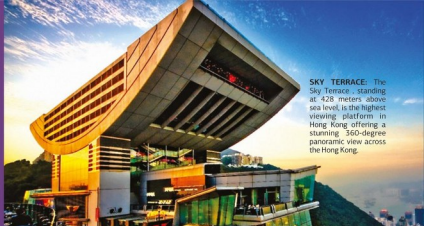

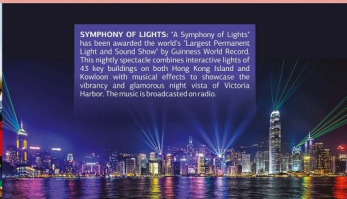

HONG KONG CULTURE

Hong Kong is frequently described as a place where "East meets west", reflecting the culture's mix of the territory's Chinese roots with influences from its time as a British colony. Concepts like Feng Shui are taken very seriously, with expensive construction projects often hiring expert consultants, and are often believed to make or break a business. Other objects like Ba gua mirrors are still regularly used to deflect evil spirits, and buildings often lack any floor number that has a 4 in it, due to its similarity to the word for "die" in Cantonese.

Hong Kong is a recognized global centre of trade, and calls itself an "entertainment hub". Its martial arts film genre gained a high level of popularity in the late 1960s and 1970s.

Several Hollywood performers, notable actors and martial artists have originated from Hong Kong cinema, notably Bruce Lee, Jackie Chan, Chow Yun-fat, Michelle Yeoh, Maggie Cheung and Jet Li.

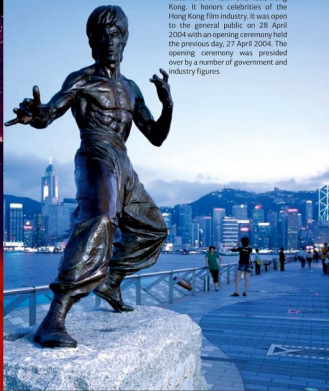

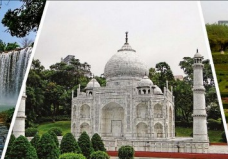

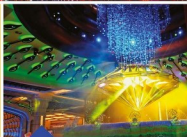

BIRD'S NEST OLYMPIC STADIUM



BEIJING

Beijing, the capital of China, is a city where the ancient culture and the modern civilization are well integrated. **GREAT WALL OF CHINA:** One of the great wonders of the world, and the only Man-made structure visible from the moon. The Chinese worked on the Great Wall for over 1 700 years. In turn, each emperor who came to power added pieces of the wall to protect their dynasties. The total length of the wall has already reached 5,107 miles and 35 feet tall, belonging to different states. Badaling section, Juyong pass and Cloud Terrace were listed as important historical monuments.

MING TOMBS: In total, 13 emperors were buried in this place, also known as the "Thirteen Ming Tombs". The Ming Tombs cover an area of 4 square kilometers and the whole construction of the 3 tombs took more than 200 years.

BEIJING NATIONAL STADIUM (BIRD'S NEST/ OLYMPIC STADIUM): The main track and field stadium for the 2008 Summer Olympics and is host to the Opening and Closing ceremonies. The capacity of the stadium is 80,000 seating. Length of the Stadium is 333 m long from north to south and 294 m width from east to west. Total height of the stadium is 69.2 m tall. The stadium is referred to as the 'Bird's Nest' because of its saddle-shaped steel roof and interwoven facade.

SUMMER PALACE: Regarded as the largest imperial garden in China, Beijing's Summer Palace is in fact a park-styled royal retreat extending out over 10 square miles in northwest suburban Beijing.



WATER CUBE: The blue-colored National Aquatics Center (NAC), nicknamed the "Water Cube" and located by Beijing's North Fourth Ring Road, was inaugurated and delivered for use on the morning of January 28, 2008. Located in the south-western part of Olympic Green's Central Zone, the National Aquatic Center can be reached from all four main entries of Olympic Green. The center will be the venue for swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water-polo final during the Olympic Games.





TEMPLE OF HEAVEN : Temple of heaven the place where the emperors of the Ming & Qing dynasties prayed for a good harvest. It boasts of the largest sacrificial place in Beijing among a few imperial altars to the Heaven, the Earth, the Sun, and the Moon-super natures.

FORBIDDEN CITY: Forbidden City is the world's largest palace complex. 960 meters from north to south and 750 meters from east to west, it covers 7,20,000 square meters.



TIANANMEN SQUARE : Tiananmen Square is the largest open-urban square in the world. Tian'anmen was built in 14-17 and renovated in 1981; it was the symbol of New China. On 1st October 194-9, Chairman Mao at Tian'anmen Square proclaimed the founding of the People's Republic of China. Located in the center of Beijing, it is the largest city square in the world.



ACROBATIC SHOW : Acrobatics is an interactive art form. In Beijing (and Shanghai) one can see breath-holding acrobatics, some of which can be so demanding in the timing and balancing skill as to verge on the impossible.



XIAN

Xian, is situated in the middle part of the Yellow River, is one of the four ancient civilized capital city in the world and is synonymous with Athens, Rome and Cairo.



TERRA COTTA WARRIORS: The terra cotta warriors were created by the first Emperor of China, Qin Shi Huang di. Terra Cotta Warrior is 2000 year old. See more than 6000 molded soldiers, officers, horses and wag ons of this fame darry.



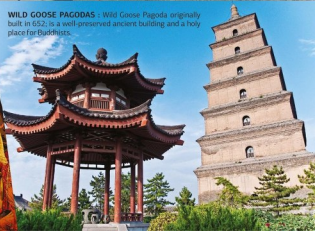
CITY WALL : It is one of the oldest and best preserved Chinese city wall, wall measured 25.7 km in length, 12- 16m in thickness at the base.

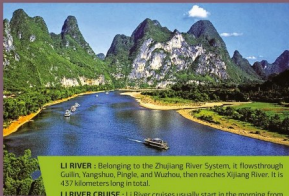


WILD GOOSE PAGODAS : Wild Goose Pagoda originally built in 652; is a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists.



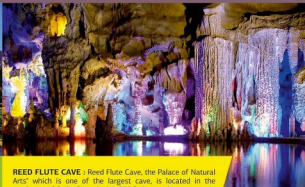
GUILIN

An area that has inspired the generations of Chinese artist and poets, the mountain scenery of Guilin is among the most spectacular of all china.

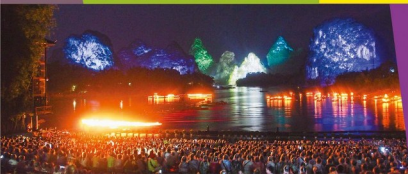


LI RIVER : Belonging to the Zhujiang River System, it flowsthrough Guilin, Yangshuo, Pingle, and Wuzhou, then reaches Xijiang River. It is 437 kilometers long in total.

LI RIVER CRUISE : Li River cruises usually start in the morning from Guilin and arrive at Yangshuo after lunch. The entire journey lasts about for four hours. Boats are air-conditioned. You can stay inside or enjoy the lovely river breezes on the open deck.



REED FLUTE CAVE : Reed Flute Cave, the Palace of Natural Arts' which is one of the largest cave, is located in the northwest of Guilin City, which is 790 ft deep within a mountain and is filled with stalactites & stalagmites. The Vibrant colors of this stalactite will leave you spell bound.



IMPRESSION SANJIE LIU SHOW: Impression Sanjie Liu is a major performance, which is set in the natural landscape of Yangshuo, and is directed by the famous Chinese director, Zhang Yimo. The stage for the performance is composed of a two-kilometer-long water area with twelve mountains as the background. It is the largest natural theater in the world. The whole performance lasts for about 60 minutes with a cast of some 600 performers, all of whom are local fishermen. The site of the great performance is about one kilometer away from the West Street.

ELEPHANT HILL : Elephant Hill- the symbol of Guilin, which resembles a giant elephant drinking water from the Li River. This hill resembles an elephant sucking water.

THE THREE GORGES DAM

The Three Gorges Dam is the largest hydroelectric dam in the world. It is located in the middle of the three gorges on the Yangtze River, the third longest in the world, in the Hubei Province of China. The project was approved by the Chinese government in 1992. However, construction didn't begin until 1994. The dam body was completed in 2006. Coupling the dam's 32 main turbines with two smaller generators (50 MW each) to power the plant itself, the total electric generating capacity of the dam is 22,500 MW.

YANGTZE RIVER

Yangtze River is the longest river in Asia and the third-longest in the world. It flows for 6,300 kilometers (3,915 mi) from the glaciers on the Qinghai-Tibet Plateau in Qinghai eastward across southwest, central and eastern China before emptying into the East China Sea at Shanghai. The river is the longest in the world to flow entirely within one country.

YANGTZE RIVER CRUISE

Shanghai is one of the busiest port as well as the center for industry and commerce.



THE ORIENTAL PEARL TOWER: Located in Pudong Park in Lujiazui. It is 468 meters high (1,536 feet). It is the world's third tallest TV and radio tower. Oriental Pearl TV Tower one of the most attractive place anywhere. The inner tower is a recreational palace, while the Shanghai Municipal History Museum is located in the tower's pedestal. It is a very famous museum.



MAGLEV TRAIN: Shanghai Maglev Train (SMT) has been operated since the end of 2002. It is the world's first and only commercialized maglev train line in operation. It runs from Pudong International Airport to Longyang Rd. Station located at the intersection of Longyang Road and Baiyang Road in Pudong New Area. The whole journey takes only eight minutes.



JADE BUDDHA TEMPLE: In the western part of Shanghai, a very modern and flourishing city, there is a venerable and famous Buddhist temple, Jade Buddha Temple. In 1882, an old temple was built to keep two jade Buddha statues which had been brought from Burma by a monk named Huigen. The temple was destroyed during the revolution that overthrew the Qing Dynasty. Fortunately the jade Buddha statues were saved and a new temple was built on the present site in 1928. It was named the Jade Buddha Temple.



YUYUAN GARDEN: Yuyuan Garden is a famous classical garden located in Anren Jie, Shanghai. The garden was finished in 1577 by a government officer of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644) named Pan Yunduan. Yu in Chinese means pleasing and satisfying, and this garden was specially built for Pan's parents as a place for them to enjoy a tranquil and happy time in their old age. The Inner Garden is compact and exquisite, and the rocks, pavilions, ornamental ponds and flower walls offer some of the most attractive sceneries in Yuyuan Garden.



HUANGPU RIVER CRUISE: Huangpu River, a symbol of Shanghai, originates in Dianshan Lake and empties into the Yangtze River at Wusongkou. The river divides Shanghai into east and west. It is a silent eyewitness to Shanghai's history and its development. Cruising on the Huangpu River has become a must for most visitors to Shanghai.



CHINESE TEA

Tea is an important part of Chinese tradition. Tea production has played a vital role in driving economic development. The practice of tea culture can bring the spirit and wisdom of human beings to a higher orbit. Tea has an extremely close relationship to Chinese culture. It not only embodies the spirit of civilization, but also the spirit of ideological form. The main varieties of Chinese tea are classified as green tea, red tea (black tea), Wulong tea, white tea, yellow tea, and reprocessed tea.

CHINESE POTTERY & PORCELAIN

Porcelain is made from a hard paste made of the clay kaolin and a feldspar called petuntse, which cements the vessel and seals any pores. China has become synonymous with high-quality porcelain. Most china pots come from the city of Jingdezhen in China's Jiangxi province. Jingdezhen, under a variety of names, has been central to porcelain production in China since at least the early Han Dynasty.



CHINESE RED LANTERNS

- a famous Chinese symbol

Chinese red lanterns have a long history, and they have become a well-known symbol of China Towns worldwide. They started out as a practicality and evolved into elaborate status symbols, literally riddled with mystery. Typical for ancient Chinese society, one such celebration is the Lantern Festival, i.e. Little New Year, so named because it is the culmination of the Chinese New Year festival. Best places to go for Lanterns are Beijing, Hong Kong and Nanjing.



CHINESE SILK

It is well known that silk is discovered in China as one of the best materials for clothing - it has a look and feeling of richness that no other materials can match. Silk, one of the oldest fibers known to man. However, very few people know when or where or how it is discovered. Actually, it could date back to the 30th Century BC when Huang Di (Yellow Emperor) came into power.



CHINESE PAINTING

Traditional Chinese painting involves essentially the same techniques as Chinese calligraphy and is done with a brush dipped in black or colored ink; oils are not used. As with calligraphy, the most popular materials on which paintings are made of paper and silk. The finished work can be mounted on scrolls, such as hanging scrolls or hand scrolls. Traditional painting can also be done on album sheets, walls, lacquer ware, folding screens, and other media.



CHINESE PAPER CUT ART

Chinese Paper Cutting or Jianzhi is the first type of paper cutting design, since paper was invented by Cai Lun in the Eastern Han Dynasty in China. The art form later spread to other parts of the world with different regions adopting their own cultural styles. Because the cut outs are also used to decorate doors and windows. Paper-cutting originated from ancient activities of worshipping ancestors and gods, and is a traditional Chinese culture.



CHINESE KUNG FU

Chinese kung fu, also known as wushu or Chinese martial arts, is one of the most well known examples of traditional Chinese culture. It is probably one of the earliest and longest lasting sports which utilizes both brawn and brain. Chinese kung fu is a large system of theory and practice. It combines techniques of self-defense and health-keeping.



BULLET TRAIN

The Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway, short for Jinghu High-Speed Railway, has been under construction from April, 2008. It has been put into commercial service on June 30, 2011. This rail line has a total length of 1,318km and serves over 50 pairs of bullet trains shuttle between the two cities everyday.



LION DANCE

It is a form of traditional dance in Chinese culture and other Asian countries in which performers mimic a lion's movements in a lion costume. The lion dance is usually performed during the Chinese New Year and other Chinese traditional, cultural and religious festivals. The Chinese lion dance is often referred to as Dragon dance. There are two main forms of the Chinese lion dance, the Northern Lion and the Southern Lion.

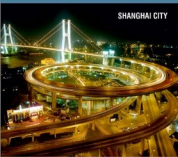

ASAKUSA SENSO JI

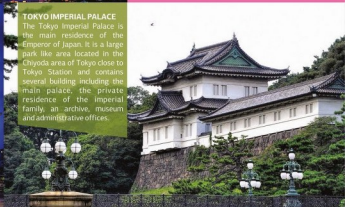
Senso Ji is an ancient Buddhist Temple located in Asakusa, Tokyo, Japan. It is Tokyo's oldest temple, and one of its most significant. Adjacent to the temple is a Shinto Shrine, the Asakusa Shrine. The temple is dedicated to the bodhisattva Kannon. According to legend, a statue of the Kannon was found in the Sumida River in 628 by two fisherman, the brothers Hinokuma Hamanari and Hinokuma Takenari. Senso ji is the focus of Tokyo's largest and most popular festival, Sanja Matsuri.

TOKYO IMPERIAL PALACE

The Tokyo Imperial Palace is the main residence of the Emperor of Japan. It is a large park like area located in the Chiyoda area of Tokyo close to Tokyo Station and contains several building including the main palace, the private residence of the Imperial family, an archive, museum and administrative offices.



GINZA

The Ginza is Tokyo's most famous upmarket shopping, dining and entertainment district, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants, night clubs and cafes. One square meter of land in the district's center is worth over ten million yen, making it one of the most expensive real estate in Japan. It is where you can find the infamous \$10 cups of coffee and where virtually every leading brand name in fashion and cosmetics has a presence.

MOUNT FUJI:

Mount Fuji is with 3776 meters Japan's highest mountain. Mount Fuji is the highest volcano and highest peak in Japan and considered one of the 3 Holy Mountains (along with Mount Tate and Mount Haku). Fuji is a perfect, beautiful stratovolcano about 60 miles south-west of Tokyo, with an exceptionally symmetrical shape making it into famous symbol of Japan and an important element in Japanese art. It is a popular destination for excursions. More than 200,000 people climb to the top of the Mt Fuji every year. The last eruption of Mt Fuji was in 1707-08. Between 2000 and 2001, seismic activity under the volcano was at slightly elevated levels, rising concern about a possible reawakening of the volcano.

LAKE ASHI CRUISE:

The Hakone Pirate Ships are sightseeing cruise ships, which are decorated as replicas of pirate ships. The Hakone Pirate Ships are a famous sight on Lake Ashi and a Hakone icon. The Hakone Pirate Ships are the main form of transport between the Hakone Ropeway Station at Togendai. From the deck of the Hakone Pirate Ships you can enjoy the scenery Lake Ashi including the vermilion shrine gate of Hakone Shrine. There is even a small chance that the weather will be clear enough to allow a clear view of Mt Fuji.



OSAKA CASTLE:

The Osaka Castle was built in the end of the 16th century by Toyotomi Hideyoshi, a well-known warlord who brought the whole country under his rule in the late 16th century. It has been burned down in a series of battles in the 17th century, and reconstructed later. Once again it was destroyed by fire, its donjon only reduced to ashes this time, and was reconstructed at last early in the 20th century. On display at its 1st to 7th floors are various weapons, armors, and folklife items of those days. There is a view spot on the 8th floor



NARA:

Nara is the capital city of Nara prefecture located in the Kansai region of Japan. The city occupies the northern part of Nara prefecture bordering Kyoto prefecture. Eight temples, shrine and ruins in Nara remain specifically Todai Ji, Saidai Ji, Kofuku Ji, Kasuga Shrine, Gango Ji, Yakushi Ji, Toshodai Ji, and the Heijo Palace, together with Kasugayama primeval forest, collectively form Historic Monuments of ancient Nara, a UNESCO world heritage site.



TODAI JI

Todai Ji is a Buddhist temple complex, that was once one of the powerful Seven Great Temples, located in the city of Nara, Japan. Its great Buddha Hall houses the world's largest wooden statue of the Buddha Vairocana, known in Japanese simply as Daibutsu. The temple also serves as the Japanese headquarter of the Kegon school of Buddhism.

KASUGA TAISHA

Kasuga Grand Shrine is a Shinto shrine in the city of Nara, in Nara prefecture, Japan. Established in 768 AD and rebuilt several times over the centuries, it is the shrine of the Fujiwara family. The interior is famous for its many bronze lanterns, as well as the many stone lanterns that lead up the shrine. Kasuga shrine and the Kasugayama primeval forest near it, registered as a UNESCO world heritage site as part of the historic monuments of ancient nara.



HIROSHIMA

Hiroshima is the capital of Hiroshima prefecture and the largest city in the Chugoku region of western Honshu, the largest island of Japan. It is best known as the first city in history to be targeted by a nuclear weapon when the U.S. army air forces dropped an atomic bomb on it at 8 15 am. On August 6, 1945, neat the end of world war 2. Hiroshima gained city status on April 1, 1889. On april 1, 1980, Hiroshima became a designated city.



HIROSHIMA PEACE MEMORIAL

Hiroshima Peace Memorial commonly called the atomic bomb dome in Hiroshima, Japan is part of the Hiroshima peace memorial park and was designated a UNESCO world heritage site in 1996. The ruins serves as a memorial to the people who were killed in the atomic of Hiroshima on 6th August 1945. Over 70000 people were killed instantly and another 70000 suffered fatal injuries from the radiation.

ITSUKUSHIMA SHRINE

Itsukushima Shrine is a Shinto shrine on the island of Itsukushima, best known for its "floating" torii gate. It is in the city of Hatsukaichi in Hiroshima prefecture in Japan. The shrine complex is listed as a UNESCO world heritage site, and the Japanese government has designated several building and possessions as National Treasures.



KYOTO:

Kyoto is a city located in the central part of the island of Honshu, Japan. It has a population close to 1.5 million. Formerly the imperial capital of Japan for more than one thousand years, it is now the capital city of Kyoto prefecture located in the Kansai region, as well as a major part of the Kyoto Osaka Kobe metropolitan area. One historical nickname for the city is the city of ten thousand Shrines



SHIMOGAMO JINJA SHRINE

Shimogamo Shrine is the common name of an important Shinto sanctuary in the Shimogamo district of Kyoto city's Sakyo ward. Its formal name is kamo miyaya jinja. It is one of the oldest Shinto shrines in Japan and is one of the seventeen Historic monuments of ancient Kyoto which have been designated by UNESCO as a world heritage site. The term kamo jinja in Japanese is a general reference to shimogamo shrine and kamigamo, and dating to the 6th Century, centuries before Kyoto became the capital of Japan.



NIJO JO CASTLE

Nijo Castle is a flatland castle located in Kyoto, Japan. The castle consists of two concentric rings of fortifications, the Ninomaru Palace, the ruins of the Honmaru Palace, various support buildings and several gardens. The surface area of the castle is 275000 square meters of which 8000 square meters is occupied by building. It is one of the seventeen assets of historic monuments of ancient Kyoto which have been designated by UNESCO as a world heritage site.

TO JI TEMPLE

To ji is a Buddhist temple of the Shingon sect in Kyoto, Japan. It once had a partner, Sai ji and together, they stood alongside the rashomon gate to the Heian capital. It was formally known as Kyo o Gokoku ji which indicates that it previously functioned as a temple providing protection for the nation.



MARUYAMA PARK

Maruyama park is a park in Kyoto. It is noted as the main center for cherry blossom viewing in Kyoto, and can get extremely crowded at that time of year. The park's star attraction is a weeping cherry tree which becomes lit up at night. It also become busy in new year's eve festivals.

KINKAKU JI TEMPLE

Kinkaku Ji temple officially named Rokuon Ji, is a zen Buddhist temple in Kyoto, Japan. The garden complex is an excellent example of Muromachi period garden design. The Muromachi period is considered to be a classical age of Japanese garden design. The correlation between building and its settings were greatly emphasized during this period. It was a way to integrate structure within the landscape in an artistic way.





MUST TO DO IN JAPAN

SHINKANSEN

Shinkansen is a network of high speed railway lines in Japan operated by four Japan Railway Group companies. The maximum operating speed is 320 km/h. Test runs have reached 443 km/h for conventional rail in 1996, and up to a world record 581 km/h for maglev trains in 2003.



CHERRY BLOSSOM

Cherry blossom is the flower of any of several trees of genus prunus, particularly the Japanese cherry, which is called sakura after the Japanese. Cherry blossom is speculated to be native to the Himalayas. Currently it is widely distributed, especially in the temperate zone of the Northern Hemisphere such as: Europe, West Siberia, South Korea, China, Japan.

ONSEN

An onsen is a term for hot spring in the Japanese language, though the term is often used to describe the bathing facilities and inns around the hot springs. As a volcanically active country, Japan has thousands of onsen scattered along its length and breadth. Onsen were traditionally used as public bathing places and today play a central role in directing Japanese domestic tourism.



AKIHABARA

Akihabara is a district in the Chiyoda ward of Tokyo, Japan. The name Akihabara is a shortening of Akihabara which ultimately comes from Akiba, named after a fire fighting deity for a fire shrine built after the area was destroyed by a fire in 1869. Nowadays, Akihabara is considered by many to be an otaku cultural center and a shopping district for video games, anime, manga and computer goods.



KIMONO DRESS

The kimono is the traditional dress of Japan, and it is worn nowadays on formal occasions. It is sometimes accused of being an impractical form of dress, but it has the advantage of giving the wearer a graceful and elegant deportment. Women's kimono include the furisode and tomesode for formal wear, the hōmongi for paying calls, the tsukesagae, and the komon. Men's kimono include the montsuki hakama for ceremonial occasions and the haori for going out visiting.



ODAIBA

Odaiba is a popular shopping and entertainment district on a man-made island in Tokyo Bay. It originated as a set of small man-made fort islands (daiba literally means "fort"), which were built towards the end of the Edo Period (1603-1868) to protect Tokyo against possible attacks from the sea and specifically in response to the gunboat diplomacy of Commodore Perry.

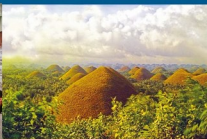
Jeepney Tour:

Individual can carry USD 3000 Cash Currency and USD 22000 Travellers Cheque / Debit Card (ICICI, AXIS, HDFC) per passport or equivalent amount for other currencies.

You should have Passport, Ticket and Business Letter against Foreign Exchange to be purchased by you and you should have Bill Copy of the Exchange purchase by you.
