UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

The United Arab Emirates is a country located in the south east end of the Arabian Peninsula on the Persian Gulf, bordering Oman to the east and Saudi Arabia to the south, as well as sharing sea borders with Qatar, Iran and Pakistan. The UAE is a federation of the seven emirates. Each Emirate is governed by hereditary emirs who jointly formed the Federal Supreme Council which is the highest legislative and executive body in the country. The constituent emirates are Abu Dhabi, Ajman, Dubai, Fujairah, Ras Al Khaimah, Sharjah and Umm Al Quwain. The capital is Abu Dhabi, which is one of the two centers of commercial and cultural activities, together with Dubai.

HISTORY

The earliest known human habitation in the UAE dated from 5000 B.C. at this early stage, there is proof of interaction with the outside world, particularly with civilizations to the northwest in Mesopotamia. Oil was first discovered in the 1950s. at the beginning of the 1960s, the first oil company took out preliminary surveys and the first cargo of crude was exported from Abu Dhabi in 1962. By 1966 it had become clear the British Government could no longer afford to administer and protect what is now the United Arab Emirates. British MPs debated the preparedness of the Royal Navy to defend the crucial sheikhdoms. On 24th January 1968, British Prime Minister Harold Wilson announced the government decision. On 2nd December 1971, at the Dubai guest house palace, four other emirates agreed to enter into a union called the United Arab Emirates. Ras Al Khaimah joined later. On 2nd November 2004, the UAE's first president, Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan, died. His eldest son Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan succeeded Khalifa as Crown prince of Abu Dhabi. In January 2006, Sheikh Maktoum Bin Rashid Al Maktoum the prime minister of the UAE and ruler of Dubai, died. And the crown prince Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum assumed both roles.

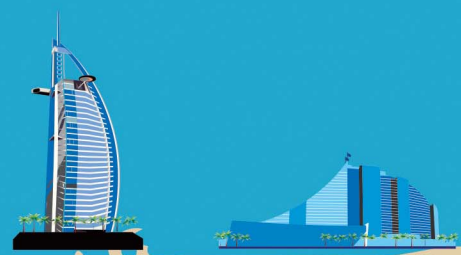

DUBAI:

Dubai is a city in the UAE, located within the emirate of the same name. The emirate of Dubai is located on the southeast coast of the Persian Gulf and is one of the seven emirates that make up the country. Dubai has the largest population in the UAE and the second largest land territory after the capital, Abu Dhabi. Dubai is the 22nd most expensive city in the world and the most expensive city in the Middle East. Dubai has also been rated as one of the best places to live in the Middle East by a American global consulting firm Mercer.

HISTORY OF DUBAI:

Records of the area where the Emirates of Dubai is situated are very rare for period before the 18th Century. During the expansion of the Sheikh Zayed Road between 1993 and 1998 remnants of a

mangrove swamp were uncovered which were dated to approximately 7000 B.C.

The Umayyads regarded as the first Muslim dynasty, introduced Islam to the area in the 7th century and sparked the revitalization of the area, opening up trade routes supported by fishing and Pearl diving to eastern regions such as modern day Iran, Pakistan and India with reports of ships as far as China to trade.

In the early 19th Century the Al Abu Falasa dynasty of the Bani Yas tribe established Dubai, which remained a dependent of Abu Dhabi until 1833.

After various rulers, Sheikh Saeed Bin Maktoum Bin Hasher Al Maktoum who became ruler in 1912, was the first ruler to rule for a substantial period of time and is regarded by many as one of the fathers of Dubai. Dubai suffered economically after 1920 due to the collapse of the pearl industry, the great depression of the 1930s and the loss of extensive trade networks during World War 2.

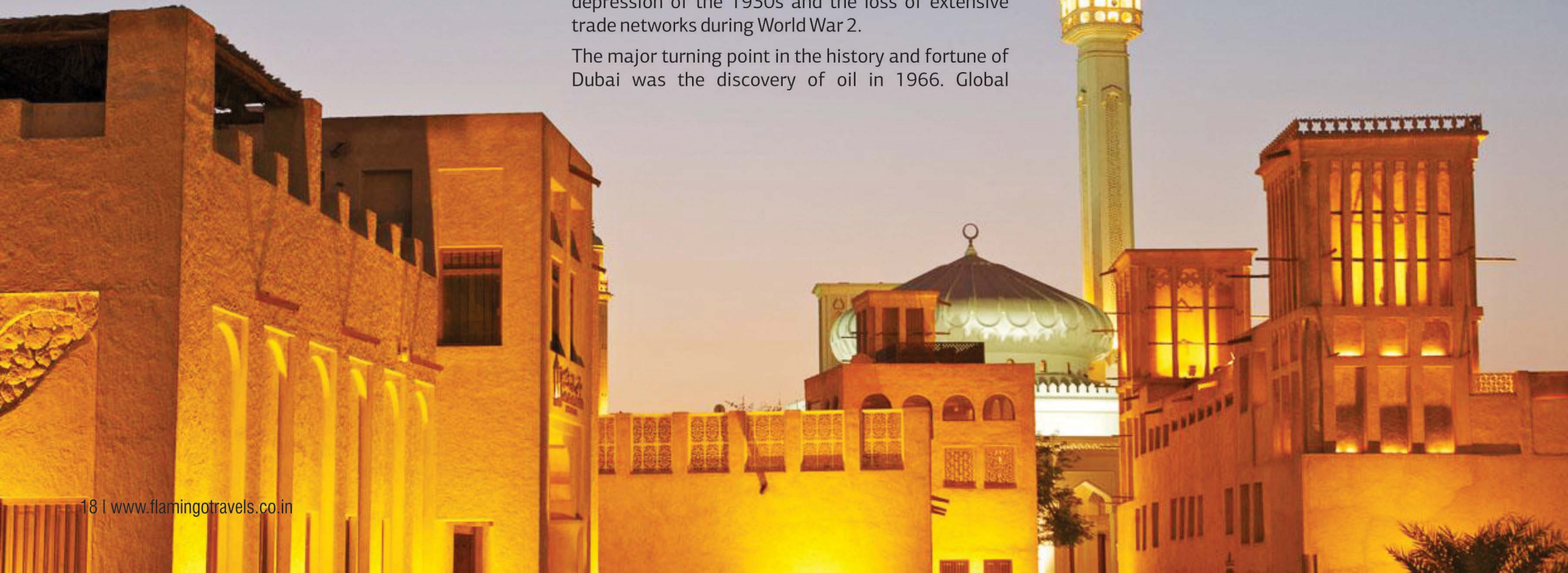
The major turning point in the history and fortune of Dubai was the discovery of oil in 1966. Global

increases in Oil prices allowed Dubai to focus on rapid development of key infrastructure. Dubai is already considered to be the Hong Kong of the Middle East.

CULTURE OF DUBAI:

The UAE culture mainly revolves around the religion of Islam and traditional Arab and Bedouin culture. In contrast, the city of Dubai is a highly cosmopolitan society with a diverse and vibrant culture.

The Islamic dress code is not compulsory. Most Emiratis prefer to wear a Kandura, an ankle length white shirt woven from wool and most Emirati women wear an Abaya, a black over garment covering most parts of the body.



HALF DAY DUBAI CITY TOUR:

The journey begins at the magnificent Jumeirah mosque and continues along the Jumeirah beach road, which is the most luxurious urban area in Dubai. Then stop for photographs at the Burj Al Arab hotel. We then head along the skyscraper area of Sheikh Zayed Road, also referred to as little Manhattan. We pass by the palace of Sheikh Mohammed, later head towards the Dubai creek, where we will stop for photographs of the creek side. We then set out on foot as we navigate through the bustling alleys towards the spice and gold souks as you see the insight of Dubai's growth as a major trading center.

FULL DAY DUBAI CITY TOUR:

The journey begins at the magnificent palace of Sheikh Mohammed and continues "Full Dubai City Tour with Dubai Museum entrance ticket "We then set out on foot as we navigate through the bustling alleys towards the spice and gold souks (markets) as you see the insight of Dubai's growth as a major trading center. Journey will continue along the Jumeirah beach road, which is the most luxurious urban area in Dubai.

Then stop for photographs at the Burj Al Arab hotel. Having spectacular views of Atlantis The Palm by Dubai Monorail (one way) , passing through Sheikh Zayed. In the evening we will visit one of the largest shopping malls of Asia - The Dubai Mall - and also have a photo stop at Burj Khalifa the tallest building in the world enjoying a musical Fountain show - the largest fountain in the world.

ATTRACTION IN DUBAI:

DUBAI METRO:

The Dubai Metro is a driverless, fully automated metre network in the city of Dubai. The Red Line is partly operational, the Green Line is still under construction, and further lines are planned. These first two lines run underground in the city centre and on elevated viaducts elsewhere. All trains and stations are air conditioned with platform edge doors to make this possible. The first section of the Red Line, covering 10 stations, was ceremonially inaugurated at 9:09:09 PM on September 9, 2009, by Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Ruler of Dubai. The Dubai Metro is the first urban train network in

the Arabian Peninsula . Once the 20 km Green line opens, the Dubai Metro will overtake the title of the longest automated meters network from the Vancouver Skytrain, surpassing it by 3 km. When completed, Dubai Metro will have 70 kilometers (43 mi) of lines, and 47 stations [including nine underground stations.

PALM ISLAND:

The Palm Islands are two artificial islands in Dubai in the shape of Palm trees. The Belgian and Dutch dredging and marine contractors Jan De Nul and Van Oord, were hired to complete the construction. The islands are the Palm Jumeirah and Palm Jebel Ali. The two islands comprise of approximately 100,000 cubic metres of rock and sand. On the two islands, there will be 100 luxury hotels, residential beach side villas and apartments, marinas, water theme parks, restaurants, shopping malls, sports facilities and health spas. The palm islands are artificial islands constructed from sand from the bottom of the Persian gulf by the Belgian company.



PALM JUMEIRAH:

The Palm Jumeirah consists of a tree trunk, a crown with 16 fronds and a surrounding crescent island that forms an 11 kilometer long breakwater. The island itself is five kilometers by five kilometers. It adds 78 kilometers to the Dubai coast line.

PALM ATLANTIS:

Atlantis, The Palm is a resort located on Dubai's reclaimed artificial island the Palm. It was the first resort to be built on the island and is based on the myth of Atlantis included distinct Arabian elements. The resort has two accommodation wings also referred to as the Royal Towers, consisting of the East and the West Tower, both linked together by the Royal Bridge suite. The resort comprises of 1500 guestrooms and suites with private balconies and views over The Palm and the Persian gulf. The imperial club has over 150 rooms and suites with exclusive services and a private club lounge and views of the Arabian sea or The Palm and Dubai Sky line. The royal bridge suite, spanning the royal towers is 22 stories up with views of the Palm, Dubai and the Persian Gulf. The two underwater suites are each three stories high with views directly into the Ambassador Lagoon.

AQUA VENTURE:

A 42-acre water park with the "Zigguret" Centerpiece that touts a 27.5 meter-vertical drop. Explore a world of breathtaking water thrills at Aqua venture. For a gentler show translating folklore themes from Persia, the Maghreb, the Levant, the Gulf region, Oman and Yemen into a spellbinding fantasy in the "Jumana" complex. The performers come from five countries: Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, France and South Africa to serve the secret of the desert. The Jumana show is unique in the Middle East and a 'must-see'. Please note: Jumana-Secret of the Desert Show is not operating during the Summer Period.

LOST CHAMBER:

Imagine exploring the mysterious ruins of Atlantis, lost for thousands of years deep beneath the sea with the entertainment of 65,000 marine animals swimming in placid waters around you.

MONORAIL:

The Jumeirah Palm Monorail was launched in may 2009 and runs along the trunk of the Palm Jumeirah in Dubai connecting the gateway station at the entry to the palm to the Atlantis hotel at the far end. The train is elevated so passengers can get a good view over the palm island as they go along. The distance of 5.45 kms is covered in eight minutes. The opening of the monorail is significant as it is reportedly the first time public railway transport of this nature has started running in the UAE, the Gulf, and the Middle East.

BURJ KHALIFA:

Burj Khalifa formerly known as Burj Dubai, is a skyscraper in Dubai, and the tallest man-made structure ever built, at 828 m (2,717 ft). The building officially opened on 4 January 2010. The building is part of the 2 km [490 acre] flagship development called Downtown Burj Khalifa with vantage point on level 124 of the world's tallest building which has highest outdoor observation deck at 442 m and its known as AT THE TOP.

DUBAI FOUNTAIN:

Set on the 30-acre Burj Dubai Lake, the fountain shoots water jets as high as 500 ft (150 metres), equivalent to that of a 50-storey building. The fountain is 900 ft (275 metres) long and has five circles of varying sizes and two central arcs. It has been designed by California-based WET, the creators of the Fountains of Bellagio in Las Vegas. Over 6,600 WET Superlights - the most advanced incandescent large fountain lights available today - and 25 colour projectors create a visual spectrum of over 1,000 abstract attractions. The beam of light shining upward from the fountain can be seen from over 20 miles away.

DUBAI AQUARIUM & UNDERWATER ZOO:

The Dubai Aquarium & Underwater Zoo is a large fish tank in The Dubai Mall, hosting thousands of fish and other underwater wildlife for visitors and residents to watch. No fishing allowed though. Enter the tunnel on the ground floor, or go to level 2 to visit the Underwater Zoo. View the fish for free from far away on ground floor, level 1 or 2, or buy a ticket for the tunnel to stand up close and make funny faces while the fish wonder if you really are the most intelligent species on the planet. You can press your nose against the glass for free if you walk behind the aquarium on level 1 or sometimes downstairs behind the tunnel entrance or exit. The Dubai Malls Dubai Aquarium and discovery centre is developed and operated by Oceanis Australian group, officially earned the Guinness World Record for the world's largest acrylic panel. The acrylic viewing panel is larger than Japan's Okinawan Churaumi Aquarium. Its 750 mm thick viewing panel can withstand pressure of 10 million litres of water used in the aquarium, but its transparency gives visitors clear views of over 33000 marine animals on display.

DESERT SAFARI:

A must for everyone who is visiting UAE. A memory to share with your family and friends back home. An experienced safari driver will drive you through the exciting desert to experience a breath taking drive in the sand dunes. After reaching the camp site you have an opportunity to do a camel ride, sand boarding, henna design and watch the belly dancer performing her show around the campfire by starlight.

DHOW CRUISE:

Traditional wooden vessels offer an intriguingly different view of this amazing city by moonlight-a port rait of the true character for Dubai, the intertwining of traditional and modern. Imagine yourself on a Dhow Cruise with the fascinating lights

of Dubai creek with music and belly dancing and be a part of a romantic dinner aboard a dhow as it slips silently along Dubai creek.

DUBAI DOLPHINARIUM:

WILD WADI:

The Wild Wadi water park is an outdoor water park in Dubai. Situated in the area of Jumeirah next to the Burj Al Arab and the Jumeirah beach hotel. The water park is operated by Jumeirah international a Dubai based hotelier. Wild wadi has a heated/ cooled wave pool, multiple water slides and two artificial surfing machines. In addition, the park has the largest water slide outside of North America, but recently it was removed to make space for two other rides.

BURJ AL ARAB:

It is designed to symbolize Dubai's urban revolution. Burj Al Arab is a luxury hotel located in Dubai. At 321 meters (1053 feet), it is the fourth tallest hotel in the world. Burj Al Arab stands on an artificial island 280 meter (920 feet) from Jumeirah beach and is connected to the mainland by a private curving bridge. The shape of the structure is designed to mimic the sail of a ship.

BIG BUS:

Dubai's exciting new tourism destination started off as a huge cultural entertainment center to cater to the need for a central meeting point where different countries could showcase myriad cultures. Global Village brings together diverse customs and cultures covering a broad spectrum of activities including music, dances, arts and handicrafts, theatre, costumes and cuisine of different countries.

BAB AL SHAMS:

Located in the heart of the Arabian Desert, the Jumeirah Bab AlShams Desert Resort and Spa is a luxurious oasis that will take you into another world of relaxation, tranquility and self-indulgence, far away from the hustle



and bustle of Dubai's city life. The resort hosts the region's first open-air traditional Arabic desert restaurant, Al Hadheerah. Belly dancing, camel rides, horse rides and delicious Arabic cuisine are just some of the exciting highlights of the evening. The Bab Al Shams Desert Resort is located just 45 minutes from Dubai. Dining here is a truly unique experience as you would expect, the decor of the restaurant has a colourful, traditional Arabic theme, with beautiful patterned rugs, large cushions, natural stone walls and a sunken dance floor. Enjoy the rich, exotic flavors and aromas of authentic Arabic cuisine while you are entertained by belly dancers, folklore dancers, singers and live Arabic bands. A special souk area showcases Arabic heritage and tradition, and there is also henna painting, fortune tellers, Sheesha, a falcon display and live cooking stations.

DUBAI MUSEUM:

Dubai Museum is the main museum in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It is located in the Al Fahidi Fort and is the oldest existing building in Dubai. The museum was opened by the ruler of Dubai in 1971, with the aim of presenting the traditional way of life in the Emirate of

Dubai. It includes local antiquities as well as artifacts from African and Asian countries that traded with Dubai. It also includes several dioramas showing life in the emirate before the advent of oil.

Entrance to the galleries is located at the tower on the southwestern corner of the fort. After descending the spiral stairs visitors enter the first gallery, where old maps of Dubai are displayed. Next is the video room showing video updated in 2007, that depicts Dubai from before the discovery of oil in 1960s to the current day. Visitors will set foot on the deck of the dhow unloading at the model creek side souq. The street leads to model mosque, house and family. A date farm, a camel, wild animals and Bedouin tent filled with jewelry, trinkets and objects from the daily life of bedouins.

DUBAI MARINA:

Dubai marina is a district in Dubai. Dubai marina is an artificial canal city, built along a two mile stretch of Persian gulf shoreline. When the entire development is

complete, it will accommodate more than 120,000 people in residential towers and villas. Dubai marina is also one of the few places where people from Western Europe form a majority. The walk at Jumeirah beach residence is a 1.7 kilometre strip at the ground and plaza level of the complex, it was developed by Dubai properties and was completed by 2007 and opened officially in August 2008. Currently there are around 330 occupants at the walk including restaurants, clothing stores, boutiques, department stores, cafes and gyms, located over two level ground and plaza.

CAVAN TOWER:

Cayan tower known as infinity tower prior to its inauguration is 306 meters high, 80 story skyscraper in Dubai. The tower is designed by Skid more, Owings and Merrill SOM architectural group, the same group who built the Burj Khalifa also in Dubai. Upon its opening on 10 June 2013, the tower has become the world's tallest high rise building with a twist of 90 degrees. The tower also includes a five story parking garage behind it. The rooms of the tower are designed in such a way that it wouldn't be affected by direct sunlight due to titanium metal panels on cast in place concrete columns aided with repetitive staggered screen panels to stop penetrating sunlight from disturbing the residents of the unit.





HELICOPTER RIDE:

Adventure Ride will be witnessed with current and future developments of the world's fastest growing region, the unfolding of a truly extraordinary city of the 21st century.

JETSKI:

The temperate of the waters of the Gulf and year-round sunshine make Dubai an ideal location for water- skiing. Each year the Dubai Water Sports Association invites top performers from Europe and the United States for a week-long competition and Festival.

HOT AIR BALLOONING:

A hot air balloon consists of a bag called the envelope that is capable of containing heated air. Suspended beneath is a gondola or wicker basket , which carries passengers and (usually) a source of heat, in most cases an open flame. The heated air inside the envelope makes it buoyant since it has a lower density than the relatively cold air outside the envelope. As with all aircraft, hot air balloons cannot fly beyond the atmosphere. Unlike gas balloons, the envelope does not have to be sealed at the bottom since the air near the bottom of the envelope is at the same pressure as the air surrounding. For modern sport balloons the envelope is generally made from nylon fabric and the inlet of the balloon (closest to the burner flame) is made from fire resistant material such as Nomex.

QUAD BIKING:

Quad Biking is a adventure sport popular in the younger crowd. It is an activity that comes as part of the desert safari trip in Dubai. Since ATV comes in various configurations of engine power, it can be ridden by anyone depending upon age. Dubai desert safari operator would give you all the equipments required for this Quad biking including your safety gears beforehand. A few minutes with these vehicles means a heart thumping action over the dunes of desert and enjoy the adreline rush.

SKI RESORT:

Ski resort is the first In-door ski resort in the Middle East and offers an amazing snow setting to enjoy skiing, snowboarding and tobogganing or just playing in the snow. Its Located in Emirates Mall. Ski Dubai is a unique mountain-themed attraction that offers you the opportunity to enjoy real snow in Dubai all year round.



JUMEIRAH BEACH:

Jumeirah Beach named after the Jumeirah district of Dubai, is a white sand beach stretching along the coast south of the city's historic district to the junction with the Palm Jumeirah and terminating between the southern end of the Jumeirah Beach Residence adjacent to the Dubai Marina district and the port facilities at Jebel Ali.



MIRACLE GARDEN:

Dubai isn't where you'd expect to find the world's biggest natural flower garden, but then again the state specialises in superlatives and the unexpected – as well as the world's tallest building and the world's tallest hotel, it includes such incongruous attractions as the substantial ski resort Ski Dubai, which is chilled all year and comes complete with real snow. Located in Dubailand near the Arabian Ranches and opened on Valentine's Day, Dubai Miracle Garden contains over 45 million flowers over a 72,000 sq metre site and, as well as traditional flowerbeds, it features topiary-style displays with blooms fashioned into the shapes of hearts, stars, igloos, pyramids and so on. Intended as a tourist attraction which should attract one million visitors a year once fully established, the site was developed by the landscaping company Akar. Floral displays will change each season so that repeat visitors will have a new experience each time.

DUBAI FERRY:

Dubai Ferry line will shuttle between Dubai Marina and Dubai Creek. In Dubai Creek, the line will move from Al Ghubaiba Station to Dubai Marina starting at 11 am, with the other journey starting at 10:30am towards the Floating Bridge, continuing up to the Hyatt Regency Hotel and back to Al Ghubaiba Station in a one-hour trip. Passengers will be served with coffee and tea on both journeys. Another journey will start at 3 pm from Al Ghubaiba Station in the direction of the Floating Bridge and up to the Hyatt Regency Hotel and back to Al Ghubaiba Station. Dubai Marina, the first morning journey of the Dubai Ferry will start at 11am in the direction of Al Ghubaiba Station, and an internal journey will start at 3pm and last for one hour. At 4pm, a journey will start from the Marina featuring a much more tourist-oriented cruise which will pass by the Burj Al Arab and Atlantis Hotels, offering passengers many opportunities to shoot stunning pictures of these iconic tourist landmarks in Dubai in a trip that takes about one hour in both directions.

RTA FERRY:

RTA means Road Transport Authority in Dubai. It covers Burj Al Arab, The Palm Jumeirah, Atlantis, Dubai Creek, Dubai Marina Mall, Al Ghubaiba. This



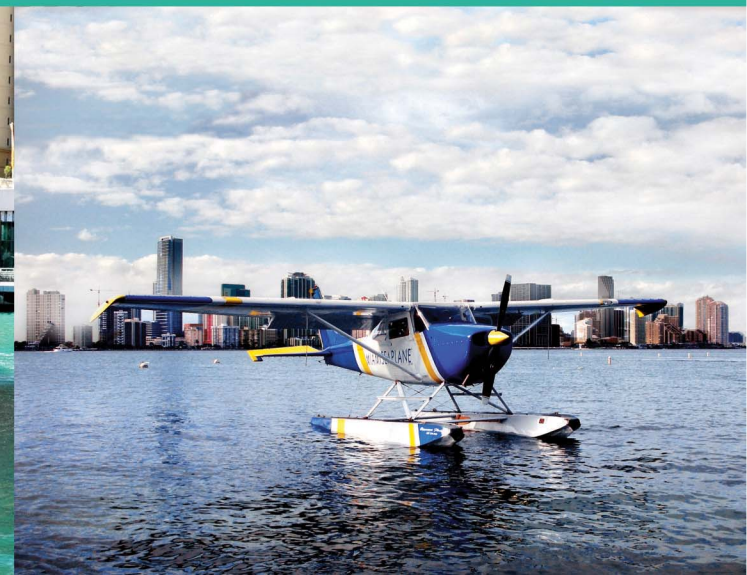

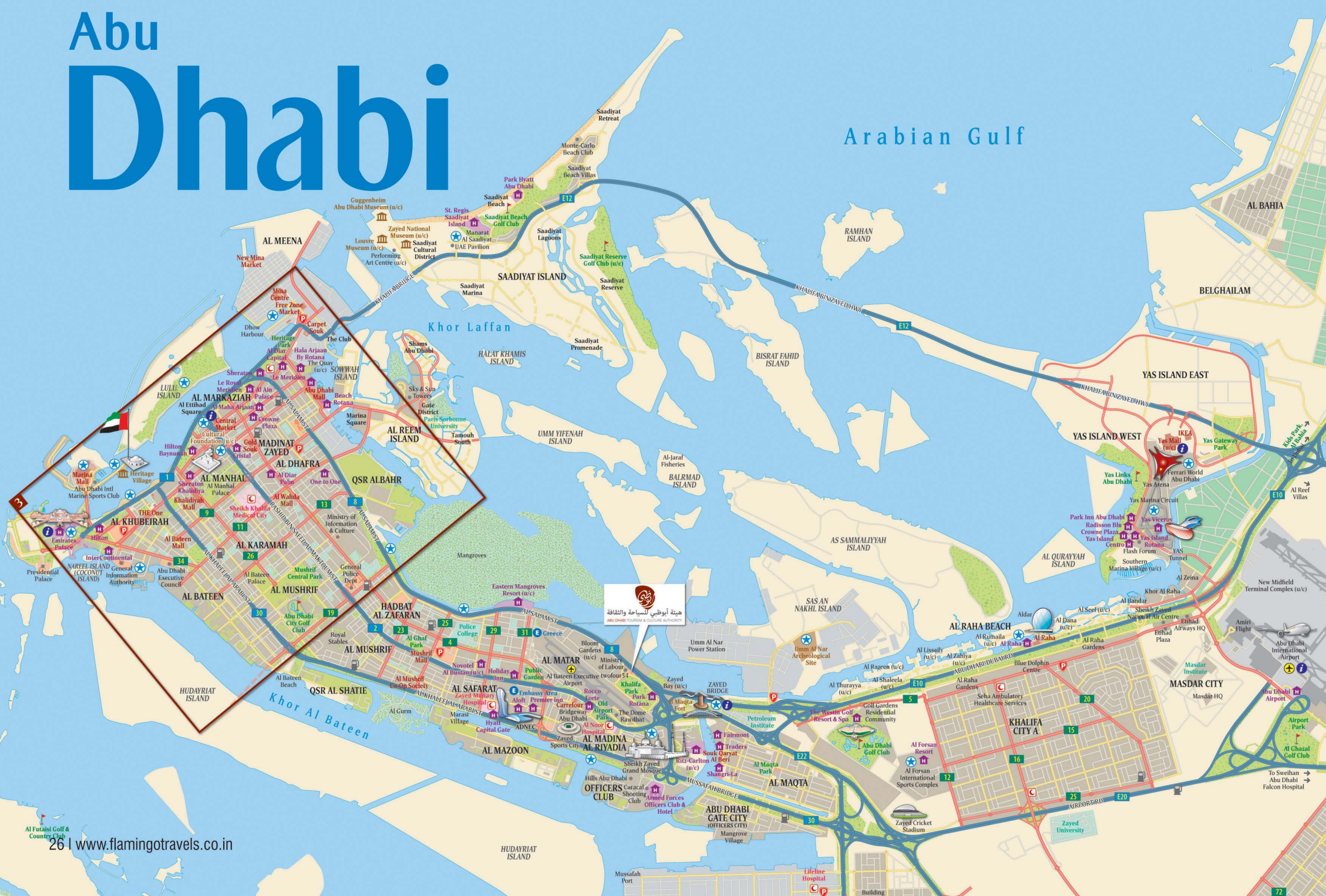
SEA PLANE:

ABU DHABI TOUR:

It is the Capital city & Business Hub of UAE. It is the largest city of the UAE with the area of 67,340 Sq. km., situated to the south of Dubai, it is actually an island connected to mainland by two bridges. Tour starts with the Carpet Market, continue with our drive around the city passing along the impressive corniche, magnificent mosques, marvelous fountains and beautiful gardens. The tour also includes a View of the City from the Break Water (Marine Drive) and a stopover at Marina Mall-(Land Acquire from Sea), Passing through the Sheikh Palace and one of the best Hotel Emirates Palace.

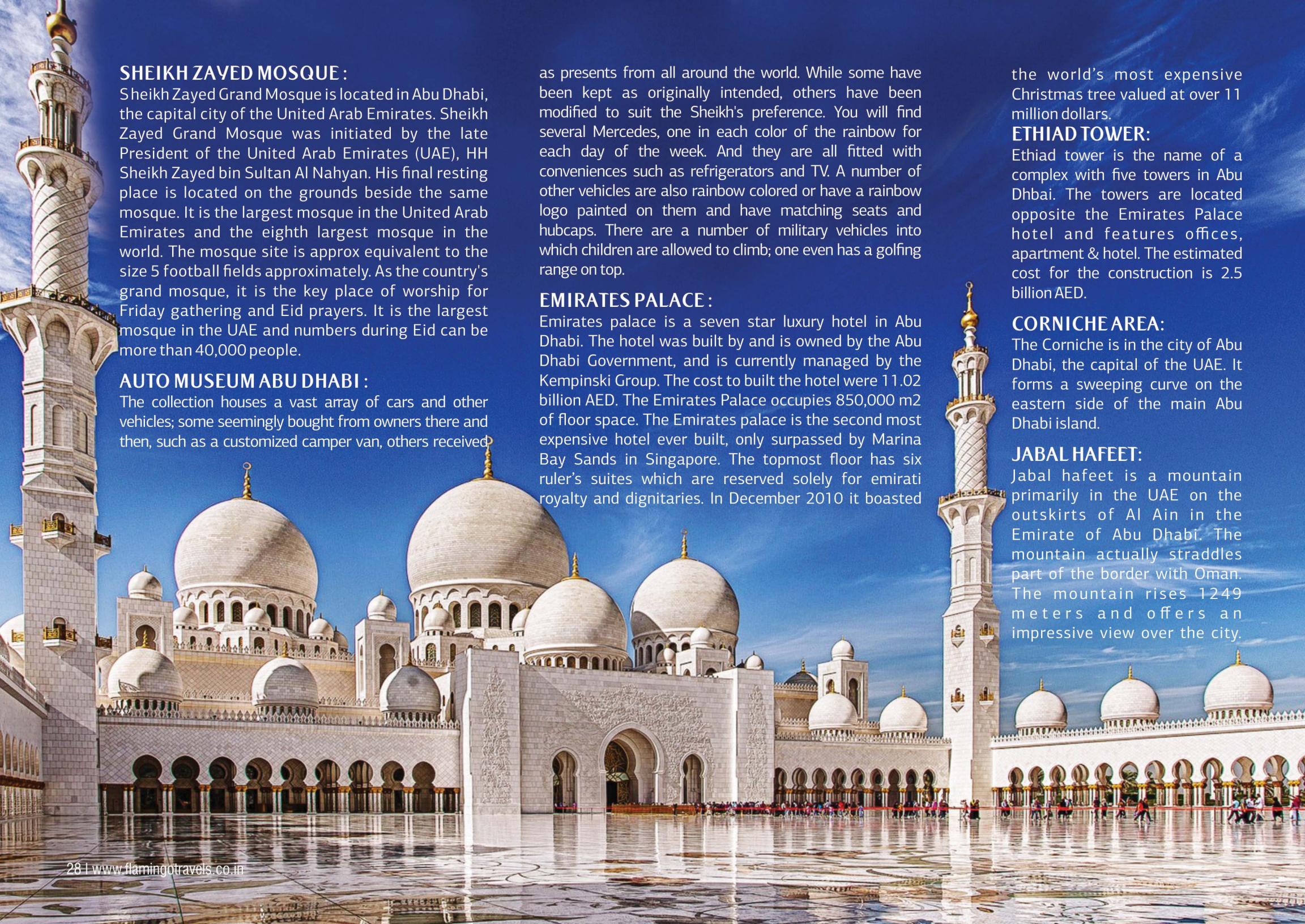
HISTORY:

Abu Dhabi is full of archeological evidence that points to civilizations, such as the Umm an-Nar culture, having been located there from the third millennium BC. Settlements were also found further outside the modern

city of Abu Dhabi but closer to the modern city of Al Ain. The origin of the name Abu Dhabi is uncertain. Meaning Father of Deer, when literally translated from Arabic. It probably referred to the few gazelle that inhabit the emirate. An old story tells about a man who used to chase deer and was named the father of the animal. In 1973, the Al Bu Falah subsection migrated to the island of Abu Dhabi on the coast of the Persian Gulf due to the discovery of fresh water there. One family within this section was the Al Nahyan family. Abu Dhabi worked in the pearl business and traded with others. According to a source about pearling, the Persian Gulf was the best location for pearls. In 1930s, as the pearl trade declined, interest grew in the oil possibilities of the region. An associate company of the Iraq Petroleum Company, entered into a concession agreement with the ruler, Sheikh Shakhbut Bin Sultan Al Nahyan, to explore for oil.

CULTURE OF ABU DHABI:

Abu Dhabi's culture is firmly rooted in Arabia's Islamic traditions. Islam is more than a religion; it is a way of life that governs everyday events from what to wear to what to eat and drink. UAE nationals usually wear traditional dress in public. For men, this is the Kandura a white full length shirt like garments, which worn with white or red checkered headdress, known as Ghutra. Sheikhs and important businessman may also wear a thin, gold trimmed robe over their kandura at important events. In public, women wear a long, loose black robe that covers their normal clothes plus a headscarf.



SHEIKH ZAYED MOSQUE :

Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque is located in Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the United Arab Emirates. Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque was initiated by the late President of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), HH Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan. His final resting place is located on the grounds beside the same mosque. It is the largest mosque in the United Arab Emirates and the eighth largest mosque in the world. The mosque site is approx equivalent to the size 5 football fields approximately. As the country's grand mosque, it is the key place of worship for Friday gathering and Eid prayers. It is the largest mosque in the UAE and numbers during Eid can be more than 40,000 people.

AUTO MUSEUM ABU DHABI :

The collection houses a vast array of cars and other vehicles; some seemingly bought from owners there and then, such as a customized camper van, others received

as presents from all around the world. While some have been kept as originally intended, others have been modified to suit the Sheikh's preference. You will find several Mercedes, one in each color of the rainbow for each day of the week. And they are all fitted with conveniences such as refrigerators and TV. A number of other vehicles are also rainbow colored or have a rainbow logo painted on them and have matching seats and hubcaps. There are a number of military vehicles into which children are allowed to climb; one even has a golfing range on top.

EMIRATES PALACE :

Emirates palace is a seven star luxury hotel in Abu Dhabi. The hotel was built by and is owned by the Abu Dhabi Government, and is currently managed by the Kempinski Group. The cost to built the hotel were 11.02 billion AED. The Emirates Palace occupies 850,000 m2 of floor space. The Emirates palace is the second most expensive hotel ever built, only surpassed by Marina Bay Sands in Singapore. The topmost floor has six ruler's suites which are reserved solely for emirati royalty and dignitaries. In December 2010 it boasted

the world's most expensive Christmas tree valued at over 11 million dollars.

ETHIAD TOWER:

Ethiad tower is the name of a complex with five towers in Abu Dhabi. The towers are located opposite the Emirates Palace hotel and features offices, apartment & hotel. The estimated cost for the construction is 2.5 billion AED.

CORNICHE AREA:

The Corniche is in the city of Abu Dhabi, the capital of the UAE. It forms a sweeping curve on the eastern side of the main Abu Dhabi island.

JABAL HAFEET:

Jabal hafeet is a mountain primarily in the UAE on the outskirts of Al Ain in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi. The mountain actually straddles part of the border with Oman. The mountain rises 1249 meters and offers an impressive view over the city.

Jebel Hafeet was a well known landmark throughout the area's history and is a contemporary tourist attraction. At the foothills of Jabal Hafeet lies the Green Mubazarrah, a well developed tourist attraction. At the Green Mubazarrah, hot water springs gush forth in little streams and form a lake.

LOUVER ABU DHABI:

The Louver Abu Dhabi is a planned museum located in Abu Dhabi. This is part of a thirty year agreement between the city of Abu Dhabi and the French government. The museum is to be located on the Saadiyat Island cultural district and will be approximately 24,000 square meters in size. The museum will be designed as a 'seemingly floating dome structure'; its web patterned dome allowing sun to filter through. The overall effect is meant to represent "rays of sunlight passing through date palm fronds in an Oasis.

MANARAT AL SAADIYAT:

Manarat Al Saadiyat means 'The place of Enlightenment'. It is a 15,400 square meter arts and culture centre, designed to bring the vision of the island to life through the Saadiyat story. The venue also features four

gallery spaces. The main galleries of Manarat Al Saadiyat constitute of permanent spaces for a series of exhibitions and educational programmes organized by TDIC. This is part of an ongoing cultural programme dedicated to developing awareness and understanding of art and culture prior to the launch of the Saadiyat Cultural district.

HILI FUN CITY:

Hili Fun City is the largest and most popular theme park in the Gulf Region. Hili Fun City features over forty rides and attractions including a looping roller coaster, the Dynamic Motion Theater, the high flying sky flyer and a host of other rides and slides. An annual festival, which celebrates the culture and history of the UAE is held at Hili Fun City in Al Ain. International variety shows are presented in a carnival atmosphere attracting thousands of visitors from around the region. Picnic facilities, food outlets, souvenir shops and variety shows are provided in addition to the selection of rides including modern favorites and the latest attractions such as Laser Dome and Gyro Tower. Adjacent to Hili Fun City is the Al Ain Ice Rink; an Olympic sized facility offering skating and numerous children's games.

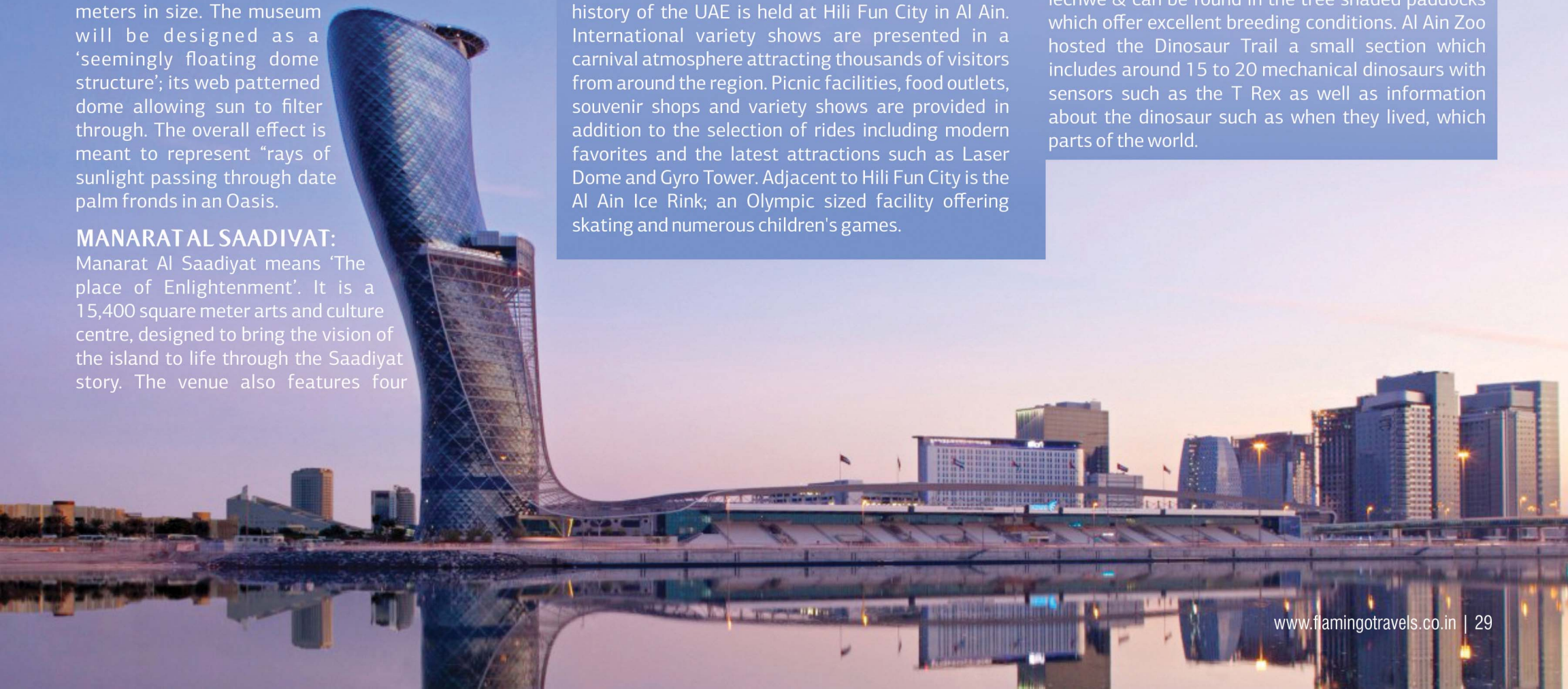
AL AIN

AL AIN PARADISE PARK:

Al Ain Paradise Garden is probably Al Ain's most famous attraction, attracting 7000 visitors in one day. Al Ain is the largest display of hanging baskets consisting of 2968 arrangements. Al Ain Paradise Park has found its way in the Guinness book of world records which has recognized it as the world's largest garden for the second time.

AL AIN WILD LIFE PARK & RESORT:

Al Ain Zoo is a 400 hectare zoo located in the foothills of the Jebel Hafeet mountains in Al Ain. It mainly comprises Arabian antelopes & oryx, eland, Gazelle, lechwe & can be found in the tree shaded paddocks which offer excellent breeding conditions. Al Ain Zoo hosted the Dinosaur Trail a small section which includes around 15 to 20 mechanical dinosaurs with sensors such as the T Rex as well as information about the dinosaur such as when they lived, which parts of the world.



VAS ISLAND:

Yas Island is known as Yas Marina Island, located in Abu Dhabi Yas Marina Circuit. It is the largest permanent sports venue lighting project in the world. In Yas Island the major attraction is a Ferrari Park & Yas Water World. These are properties made by Aldar group. Yas Island was named the world's leading tourism project at the World Travel Awards in November 2009. The island holds the Yas Marina Circuit, which hosts the Formula One Abu Dhabi Grand Prix since 2009. It occupies a total area of 2500 hectare of which 1700 hectares will be claimed for development.

FERRARI PARK:

Ferrari park is a Ferrari themed amusement park on Yas Island. It is the world's largest indoor themed park. Ferrari park officially opened on 4th November 2010. Ferrari park is a home of the world fastest roller coaster ride Ferra Rossa. In this park there are

a total of 20 rides designed for all age groups. It also gives full information about the Ferrari Car. Ferrari store is a world's largest Ferrari store in the world & Ferrari boutique capable of creating personalized souvenirs. The roof has a total surface area of 200,000 square meter with perimeter of 2,200 meters. The Ferrari logo adorns the roof of the building and measures 213 feet by 159.1 feet, the largest Ferrari logo ever created.

VAS WATER WORLD:

Yas water park is a newly opened attraction on Yas Island. It is a huge water park in Yas Island & in UAE. Visitors will be able to enjoy 43 rides, slides and attractions that follow the adventures of the water park's main character 'Dana' – a young Emirati girl in search of a legendary pearl which brought prosperity to the people of her village. The Water park on Yas Island will be operated by Farah Leisure Parks Management.

VAS MARINA CIRCUIT:

Yas Marina Circuit is the venue for the Abu Dhabi Grand Prix. The circuit is situated on Yas Island about 30 minutes from the capital of the UAE. Yas Marina Circuit is the second formula one track in the Middle East, with the first being in Bahrain. The twenty one corners twist through the Yas Island off the Abu Dhabi coast, passing by the Marina and through the Yas Viceroy Abu Dhabi Hotel.

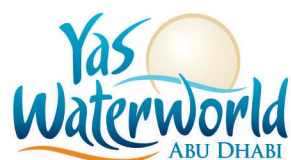

ABOUT SHARJAH:

Sharjah is one of the emirates of the UAE. The emirate covers 2600 km² and has a population of over 800,000. The emirate of Sharjah comprises the city of Sharjah and other minor towns and enclaves such as Kalba, Dibba Al Hisn and Khor Fakkan.

The city of Sharjah, which overlooks the Persian gulf. Sharjah city a sister city to Dubai and Ajman on both its borders.

HISTORY:

Human settlement in Sharjah city has existed for over 5000 years. Around 1727 the Al Qasimi clan took control of Sharjah and declared the policy independent. On 8th January 1820, Sheikh Sultan 1 Bin Saqr Al Qasimi signed the General Maritime Treaty with Britain, accepting protectorate status in order to resist Ottoman domination. On 2nd December 1971, Sheikh Khalid 3 Bin Muhammad Al Qasim joined Sharjah to the UAE. In 1972 the former ruler Sheikh Saqr staged a leftist coup and killed Khalid 3. Saqr was unable to establish his rule and fled. In 1987 Sultan's brother Abdulaziz staged a coup while Sultan was abroad. In 1999, the crown prince died of drug addiction while on vacation in their palace in England. Sultan made the decision to testify in front of UK court.

CULTURE OF SHARJAH:

Sharjah is the only emirate in which alcohol is banned. It also maintained the strictest decency laws in the UAE. Mixing between unmarried men and women is illegal.

Sharjah is now known as UNESCO's cultural capital of the Arab World heralded in 1998. The cultural policy of Sharjah art foundation also has a year along program that includes exhibitions, performances, and screenings.



THE BLUE SOUQ:

The Blue Souq is the main shopping hub of Sharjah UAE. The central market is the largest market area in Sharjah offering a unique shopping experience. Popularly known as the Blue souk. The central market Sharjah is a perfect example of Islamic design. The market has more than 600 charming shops from where one can get anything to everything. The market is popular among tourist and locals alike. Shops in the central market Sharjah sell a wide selection of silver jewellery, antiques, rugs, curios, clothes & household goods.

EYE OF EMIRATES:

Eye of Emirates is a most important place to visit. It's a 60 meters high ferris with 42 air conditioned gondolas. Ferris wheel offers an aerial view of Sharjah Corniche, lagoons and landscape, extending its horizons to neighboring Dubai. It has 42 air-conditioned cabins that go 60 meters high over Sharjah and is capable of carrying 336 passengers at a single instance.

AL MAHA DESERT RESORT:

Al Maha Desert Resort & Spa the centre of Dubai's heritage & conversation efforts, lies nestled within a green & verdant oasis amongst some of Arabia's most impressive dune and desert landscapes. Al Maha Desert Resort & spa is a tribute to traditional life in the Arabian desert. Built in the style of an ancient Bedouin settlement, the neutral toned tents shade individual suites of understated, modern luxury.

KHOR FAKKAN:

Khor Fakkan is a popular tourist destination for swimming in the natural harbor and the sandy beach. Khor Fakkan is also one of the world's leading container transshipment ports. It is strategically located on Sharjah's Indian Ocean coast, outside the sensitive Straits of Hormuz and close to the main east-west shipping routes. It is only three hours from the UAE's main centers of population, Dubai, Sharjah and Abu Dhabi on the Arabian Gulf coast. Khor Fakkan's location makes it an obvious choice for shipping lines with large transshipment volumes, who also require easy access to the UAE hinterland.

SHARJAH MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC CIVILIZATION:

The Sharjah Museum of Islamic Civilization is a museum in Sharjah. The museum covers Islamic culture, with more than 5000 artifacts from the Islamic world. Objects include calligraphy, carvings, ceramic, coins, glass, manuscripts, metalwork, and scientific instruments. His Highness Sheikh Dr Sultan Bin Mohamed Al Qasimi, a member of the Supreme Council and ruler of Sharjah, opened the museum on 5 June 2008.

SHARJAH CRICKET STADIUM:

The Sharjah Cricket Association Stadium is in the emirate of Sharjah. It was originally constructed in the early 1980s and has been much improved over the years. Between 1984 to 2003 the Sharjah ground was the venue for 206 one day international held as part of commercially sponsored one day tournaments involving three or four international teams.



Ajman



AJMAN:

Ajman is one of the seven emirates constituting the UAE. With an area of just 260 square kilometers, Ajman is the smallest emirate by area. Its seat of government is Ajman, which is bordered on its north, south and east by Sharjah. Located along the Persian Gulf, Ajman also controls Masfut, a small, inland exclave that is primarily agricultural. Approximately 95% of the population of the emirate resides in the city of Ajman, which forms part of Dubai-Sharjah-Ajman metropolitan area.

HISTORY:

On 8th January 1820, Sheikh Rashid 2 Bin Humayd Al Nuaimi signed the general Maritime treaty with Britain, accepting a protectorate to keep the Ottoman

Turks out. Four of Ajman's neighbors Sharjah, Dubai, Ras Al Khaimah and Umm Al Qaiwain, its position on the route to India made it important enough to be recognized as a salute state. On 2nd December 1971, Sheikh Rashid Ibn Humayd Al Nuaimin joined the UAE.

AJMAN NATIONAL MUSEUM:

Ajman Museum is housed in an 18th Century fortress that was used as a stronghold for the Emirates leadership and as a first line of defense. The fort was the ruler's palace and then the Ajman police station. Two wind towers and watch towers were maintained when the fort was renovated. A large gate and two cannons are located in the front of the fort.

AJMAN FORT:

The Ajman fort is believed to be built in the late 18th

century, it was built with local materials such as coral stones of the sea and gypsum, while special tree trunks brought from East Africa has been used for the ceiling. There is a huge arch built on two stands on top of its large gates, made of honey-colored sandstones. It has been described as one of the most beautiful citadels in Ajman.

SHEIKH ZAVED AJMAN MOSQUE:

There are several religious sites in Ajman, the most prominent of them being the Sheikh Zayed Ajman Mosque. The rich architecture of the mosque is impressive. The mosque is said to have been built for late Sheikh Rashid Bin Humaid Al Nuaimi, by his son and current Ruler of Ajman, Humaid Bin Rashid Al Nuaimi. The Mosque is a major landmark in Ajman city.

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ABOUT RAS AL KHAIMAH:

Ras Al Khaimah is one of the Persian Gulf Arab sheikhdoms forming the UAE. Its name means Top of the Tent. The emirates are in the northern part of the UAE, bordering Oman's exclave of Musandam. It covers an area of 1684 square K.M. The capital city and home of most resident is also called Ras Al Khaimah. The emirate had population of 210,063 at the 2005 census, of which 41.82 percent were Emirati citizens. Latest estimates put the total population at between 250,000 and 300,000. The city has two main sections, Old Ras Al Khaimah and Nakheel, on either side of creek. It is served by the Ras Al Khaimah International Airport. It consists of a northern part and a large exclave in the south and a few small islands in the Persian Gulf.

HISTORY:

Ras Al Khaimah has been the site of human habitation for several millennia and there are many

historical and archaeological sites throughout the emirate dating from different time periods, including remnants of the Umm an Nar Culture. Ancient graves were found in the Emirate in Oct 2012. The city was historically known as Julfar. Archaeological evidence has demonstrated that the settlement known as Julfar shifted location over time as harbour channels silted up. In the early 18th Century, the Al Qasimi clan established itself in Ras Al Khaimah on the Arab peninsula.

ICE LAND WATER PARK:

Escaping from the heat, Iceland water park offers thrilling amusement to visitors of all ages. With a wide variety of games, water slides and extensive food court. Iceland water park In Ras Al Khaimah opened in the second half of 2010. It is the fourth water park in the UAE. It is themed on the desert freezing over and has lots of ice, snow and other

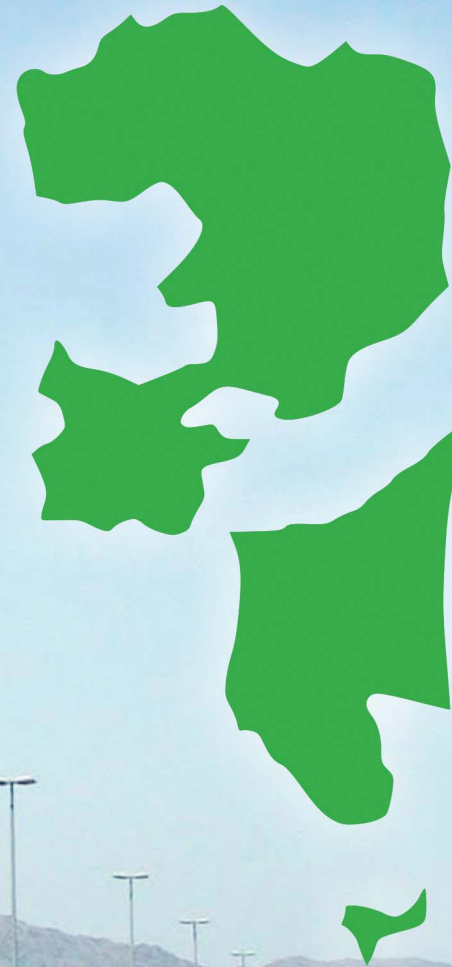
similar decorative effects together with a whole herd of model penguins. Iceland water park covers a massive area and hence has a huge number of rides to choose from. There are plenty of adrenaline filled high rides and stomach churning tubes and half pipe type rides. There is also a plunge pool where if you dare, you can jump from a height into a deep pool of water.

RAK MUSEUM:

The national museum of Ras Al Khaimah, built in mid of the 18th century during the emirates invasion by Persians was originally the house of the Royal Family until 1964. It includes a number of ancient ornaments, discovered in the emirate and is considered the wealthiest monumental museum in the UAE.



Fujairah



FUJAIRAH:

Fujairah is one of the seven emirates that make up the UAE, and the only one of the seven that has a coastline solely on the Gulf of Oman and none on the Persian Gulf.

HISTORY:

In 1902, Fujairah entered into treaty relations with Britain, becoming the last of the emirates to join the Trucial states. On 2nd December 1971, Fujairah joined the UAE. Fujairah is also home to the oldest mosque in the UAE which was built in 1446 of mud and bricks. It is similar to other mosques found in Yeman, eastern Oman and Qatar. Al Bidyah Mosque has four domes and lacks a minaret.

AL BIDYAH MOSQUE:

The Al Badiyah Mosque, sometimes written Al Bidyah or Al Bidya is the oldest known mosque in the UAE located in Al Badiyah the northern part of the emirates of Fujairah. This mosque is also known as Ottoman Mosque. It is not sure when the mosque was constructed and because the mud and stone built structure uses no wood, its exact date of construction is unknown as radiocarbon dating is not possible for structures like this. The small square

structure has an area of 53 square meters and was built from materials available in the area, primarily stones of various sizes and mud bricks coated in many of whitewashed plaster.

DIBBA:

Dibba Al Fujairah is a name of a settlement in the emirate of Fujairah located on the north east part of the UAE. It is geographically part of the Dibba region. Dibba is considered to be the 2nd largest city in the emirate of Fujairah.

WADI WURAYAH:

Wadi wurayah is a 12,700 hectares area between the towns of Masafi, Khor Fakkan & Bidiyah in the UAE. It has been designated as Ramsar Wetland of International Importance. Wadi Wurayah is home to more than 100 species of Mammals, birds, amphibians as well as more than 300 species of plants.

Famous for its scenic waterfall set

amid the Hajar Mountains. Wadi Wurayah is recommended as a must see in UAE of road and tourist guides. It is a spectacular location with streams and pools dotted around the rocky outcrops. It is one of few remaining places in the world where endangered Arabian Tahr still roams free.

MASAFI:

Masafi is a village located on the edge of the Hajar Mountains in the UAE. It developed along the old unpaved road which ran from Fujairah to Dudaia Via Sharjah. It was a trading post and refueling stop for 4x4 vehicles and camel trains that plied the route before the modern highways were built in the 1970s.

AIN AL MADHAB GARDENS:

Ain Al Madhab Gardens are located in the foothills of the Hajar Mountains, just outside the town of Fujairah. Fed by mineral springs, the warm sulfuric water is used in two swimming pools-one for women and other for men. The Ain Al Madhab Gardens are not only a mineral spa but feature a park area, the ruins of Fujairah fort and Heritage village, real life displays of traditional houses, fishing boats, costumes, pottery and cook ware.



UMMAL QUWAIN



UMMAL QUWAIN:

Umm Al Quwain is the least populous of the seven sovereign emirates in the UAE, located in the north of the country. The emirate was ruled until his death by Rashid Bin Ahmad Mu'alla, who was member of the UAE's supreme council since 1981. The emirate had 62000 inhabitants in 2003 and has an area of 750 square kilometers. Accepted alternative spellings include Umm Al Qawain, Umm Al-Qaywayn, Umm El Qiwain and Umm Al Qaiwain.

HISTORY:

The earliest settlements in Umm Al Quwain had strong Hellenistic traits, some of these are more than 7000 years old. Traces of these ancient communities are still discernible in Al Dour, near Umm Al Quwain. Arrowheads and other polished flint tools have been unearthed in various sites across the UAE while pieces of Ubaid pottery have been unearthed along the shores of the emirate. During the Bronze Age (3000-1300 BC) semi nomadic tribes inhabited the region, they shifted in groups from place to place foraging for timber from the indigenous acacia for smelting copper. The metal was sent to all the prominent ports on the Persian gulf, Umm Al Nar being one of them. The modern history of Umm Al Quwain began some 200 years ago when the Al Ali tribe moved their capital from Al Sinniyah Island to its present location in the mid 18th century due to declining water resources. On 8th January 1820, Sheikh Abdullah I signed the General Maritime Treaty with the U.K., thus accepting a British protectorate in order to keep the Ottoman Turks out.

DREAMLAND AQUA PARK:

The largest water park in the UAE is located on the coastline of Umm Al Quwain about 40 Minutes drive from Dubai with 250,000 square kilometers expanse of landscaped garden and over 30 rides, slides & attractions. The park is operated all year round with a daily capacity of ten thousand visitors.

UMMAL QUWAIN FORT:

A fort which was once home to the emirate's ruler and guarded the entrance to the old town, overseeing the sea on one side and the creek on the other. It eventually became a police station then a museum & now houses artifacts found at important nearby sites including al dour and houses a collection of weapons that were used through the emirates history. It is located near a Mosque in Umm Al Quwain Bazar.

ISLANDS OF UMMAL QUWAIN:

Islands that lie to the east of the mainland peninsula on a unique stretch of coastline consisting of sandy islands surrounded by dense mangrove forests, separated by a series of creeks. The largest of the seven islands is Al Sinniyah, followed by Jazirat Al Ghallah and Al Keabe, all of which are visible from the old town.



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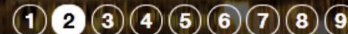
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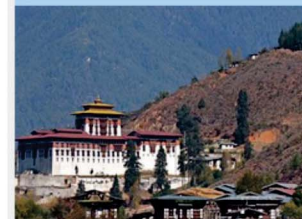
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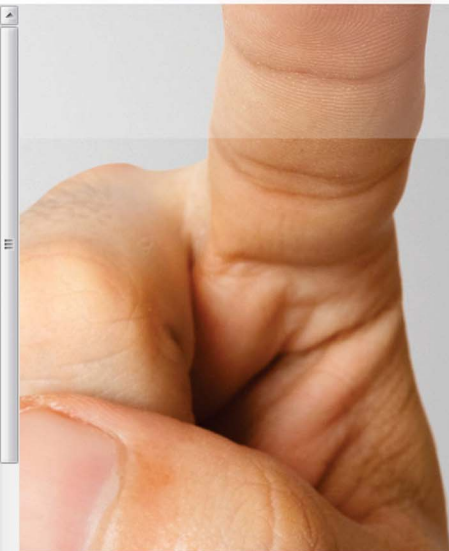


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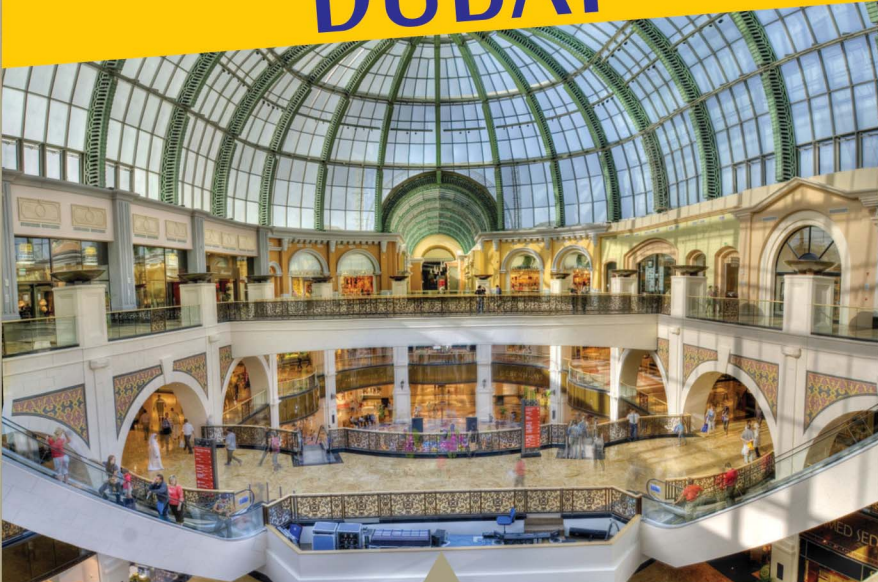

MALL OF THE EMIRATES:

Mall of Emirates, the world's first shopping resort is developed by Majid Al Futtaim properties and located in Dubai at interchange four on Sheikh Zayed Road. The multi level shopping centre currently features more than 560 international brands with a total gross leasable area including department stores, fashion, lifestyle, sports, electronics and home furnishing outlets and the largest Carrefour in the city. The compelling family leisure offers a magic planet family entertainment area, a 14 screen VOX cinemas, the world renowned ski dubai-the middle east first indoor ski resort and snow park, 500 seat capacity Dubai community theatre and arts centre and more than 90 international dining and café options.



DEIRA CITY CENTRE:

Deira City Center is located in Dubai and is the original flagship mall in the Majid Al Futtaim properties portfolio. Deira City Centre opened in 1995, and receives over 20 million visitors annually. Deira city center has 120,014 square meters and over 370 retail stores. The malls anchor stores include Carrefour, Debenhams, Iconic, Sharaf DG, Virgin megastore and Paris Gallery. The mall also houses VOX cinemas, an 11 screen multiplex cinema, Magic planet family entertainment center, over 58 international dining options, fitness first facility and a link to the Dubai Metro Station.

DUBAI MALL:

The Dubai Mall is the world's largest shopping mall based on total area and sixth largest by gross leasable area. It is part of the 20 billion dollar downtown dubai complex, and includes 1200 shops. Dubai Mall opened on 08th May 2009 with about 635 retailers, marking the world's largest ever mall opening in retail history. The mall has over 14,000 parking spaces across 3 car parks with valet services and a car locator ticketing system. The mall has won five awards - two awards at the Retail Future Project Awards at Mopic, Cannes.

MARINA MALL:

Marina Mall is an Abu Dhabi shopping mall and entertainment venue which opened in 2001. Marina mall is located along the breakwater on Corniche road, close to the Emirates Palace Hotel. Marina Mall, 122,000 square meters of retail space featuring a unique selection of fashion, leisure and entertainment brands arranged over four levels, in addition to a 100 meter observatory.



YAS MALL:

Yas Mall has the largest enclosed gathering space of any shopping center in the middle east reinforcing the mall's important role in the community. There will be over 60 food and beverages offers, which includes the cheese cake factory and rogo's rollercoaster restaurant.



KHALIDIYAH MALL:

All the walls are the color of the light brown stone that can be found on all structures in Ancient Egypt.



IBN BATTUTA MALL:

The Ibn Battuta Mall is a large shopping mall on the Sheikh Zayed Road in Dubai close to interchange 6 for Jebel Ali Village. Having more than 270 shops, 50 restaurant, a 21 screen cinema and over 4500 parking spaces on a total of 521,000 square meters, Ibn Battuta is the world's largest themed shopping mall. Ibn Battuta consists of six courts: Egypt Court, India Court, China Court, Andalusia Court, Persia Court, Tunisia Court.

MERCATO SHOPPING MALL:

Mercato Shopping mall is a shopping center in Jumeirah, Dubai. The mall is designed to look like a Mediterranean town during the European Renaissance in either Italy, France Or Spain. The Mercato comes from the Italian word meaning market.



DRAGON MART:

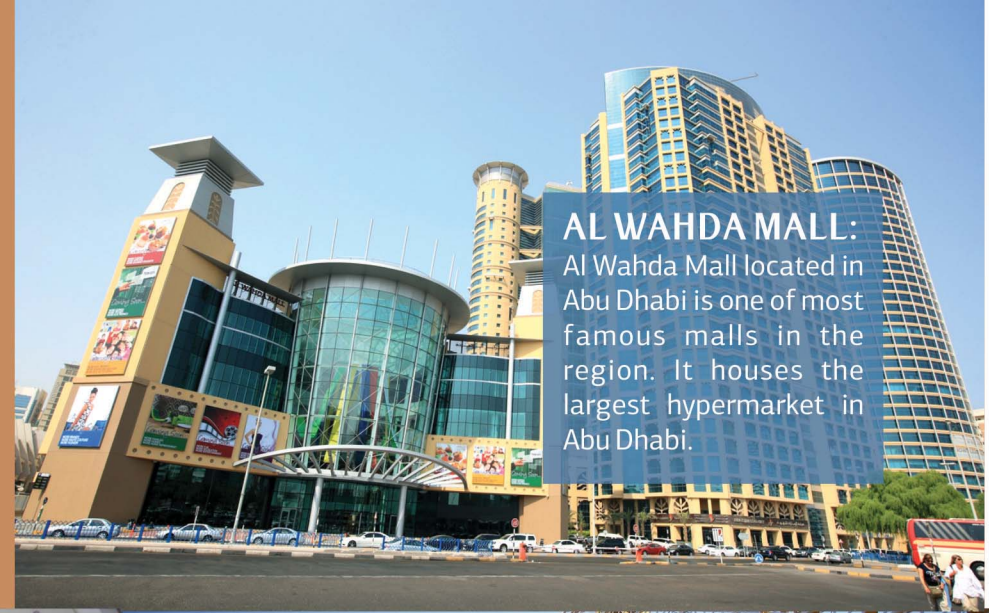
