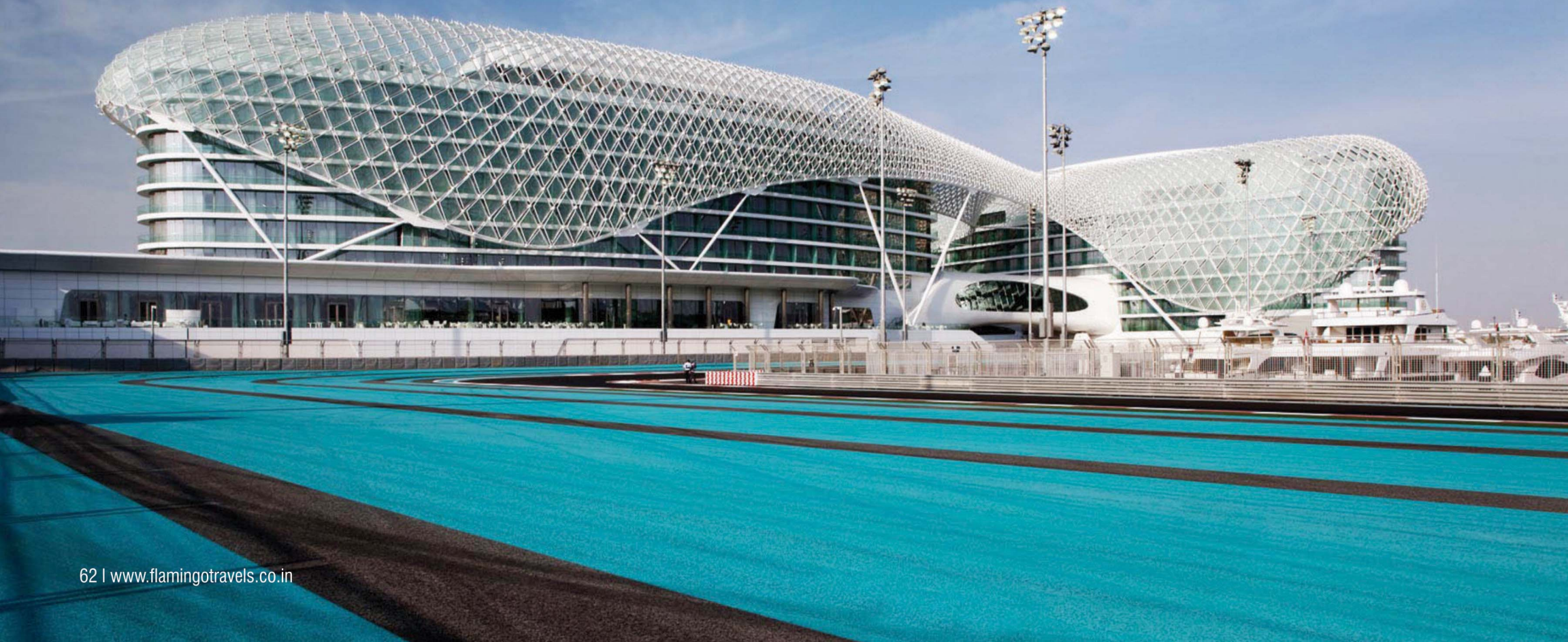

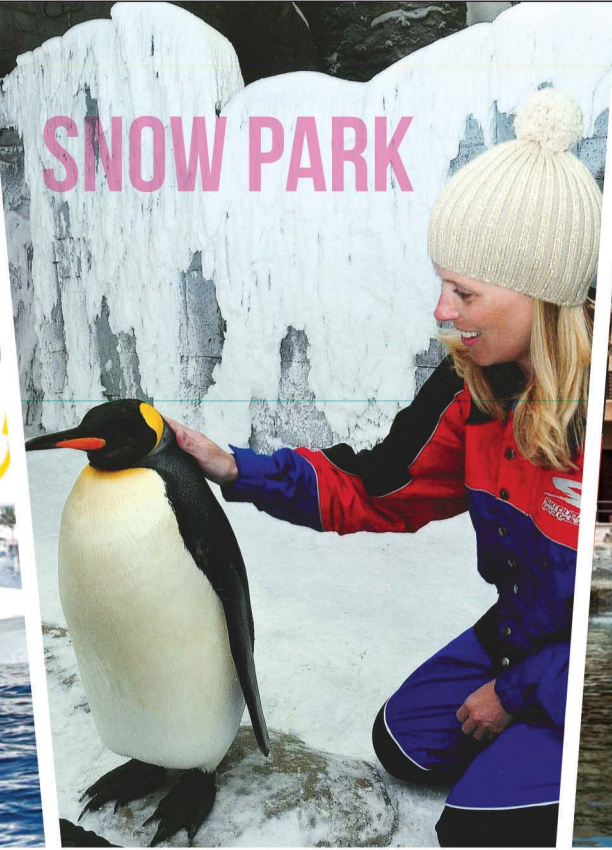

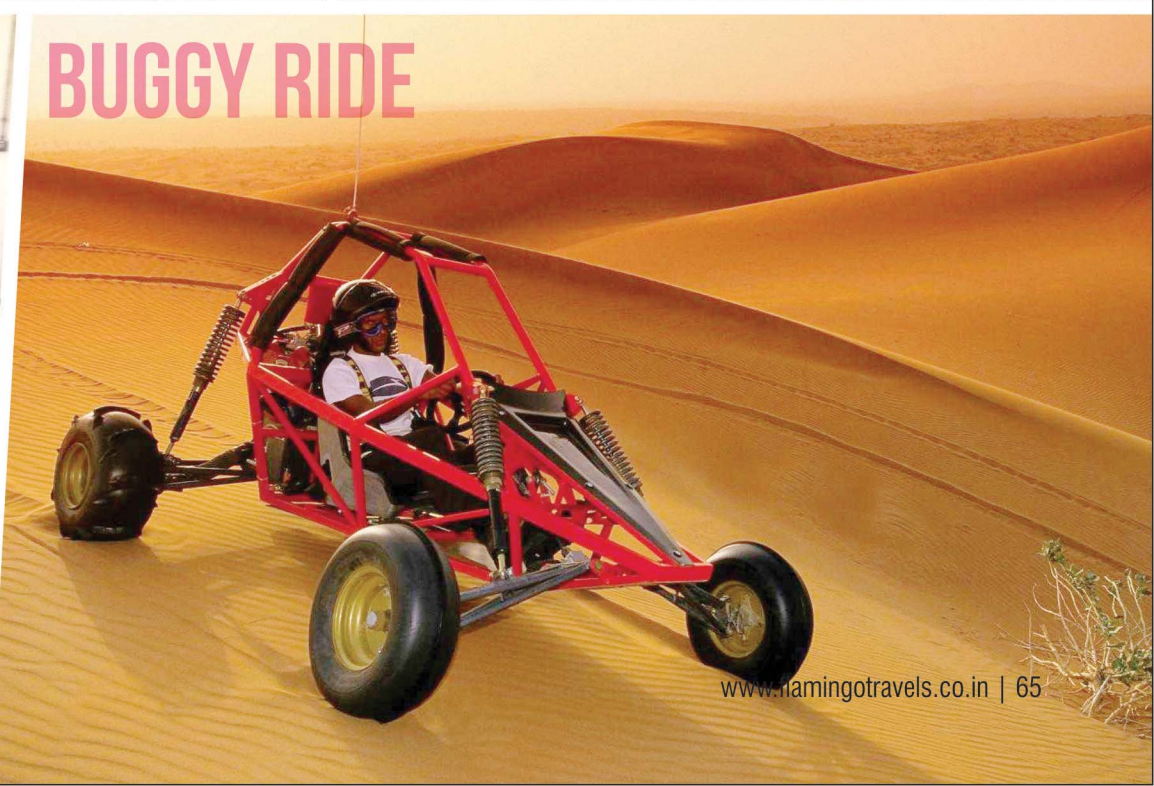

Ride The Metro Around Town

Dubai Metro is a driverless, fully automated metro rail network in Dubai. All Trains are air conditioned with platform edge doors to make this possible. Guinness World Records has declared Dubai Metro to be the World's longest fully automated metro network with a route length of 75 Kilometers.

Visit Deira Gold Souk

Deira Gold Souk is a traditional market in Dubai. The souk is located in the heart of Dubai's commercial business district in Deira, in the locality Al Dhagaya. The souk consists of over 300 retailers that trade almost exclusively in jewellery. By some estimates, approximately 10 tons of Gold is present at any give time in the souk.



Marina Walk

The Walk at Jumeirah beach Residence is a 1.7 kilometres strip at the ground and plaza level of the complex, it was developed by Dubai properties, and was completed by 2007 and opened officially in August 2008. The walk including restaurant, clothing stores, boutiques, department stores, cafes any gyms.



Abra Transportation

One of the more traditional means of getting across Dubai Creek between Bur Dubai and Deira is on Abras, small boats that ferry passengers across the creek between stations in Bastakiya and Bani Yas Road, for a nominal charge of 1 AED.



Madinat Jumeirah Mall

Souk Madinat Jumeirah is an authentic re creation of an ancient marketplace with traditional Middle Eastern Style and ambience, located in the Heart of Madinat Jumeirah. Visitors enter a world reminiscent of ancient Arabia through sight, smell and sound as sunlight peeks in through the wood carved archways showcasing intricate Arabic architectural design.

Ras Al khor wild life sanctuary is a wetland reserve renowned for attracting migratory birds in large numbers. The wetlands have large numbers of birds, crustaceans, small mammals and fish. Ras Al Khor wildlife sanctuary represents an enclave of relative wilderness amidst swirling traffic and sparwling urban infrastructure.

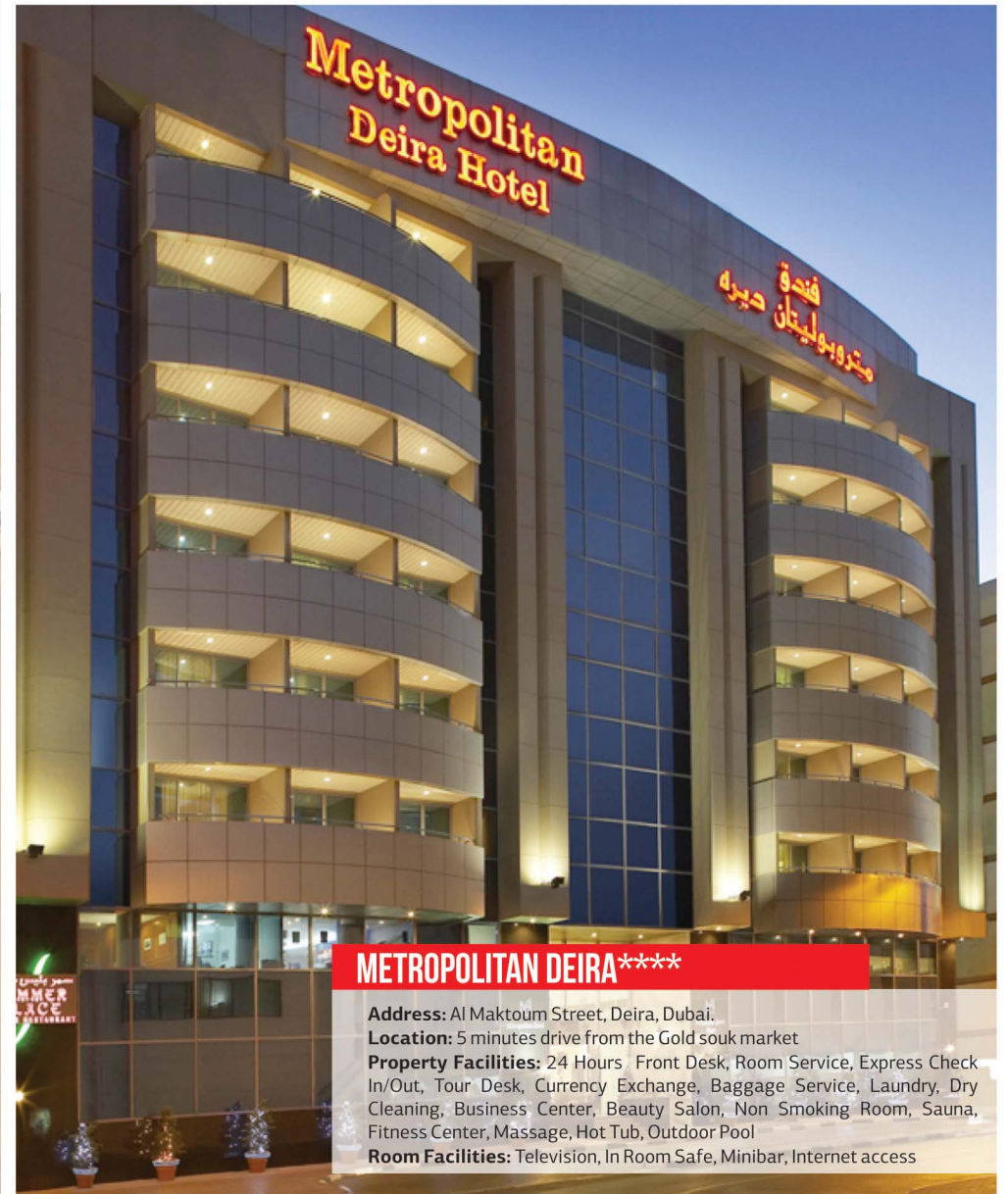

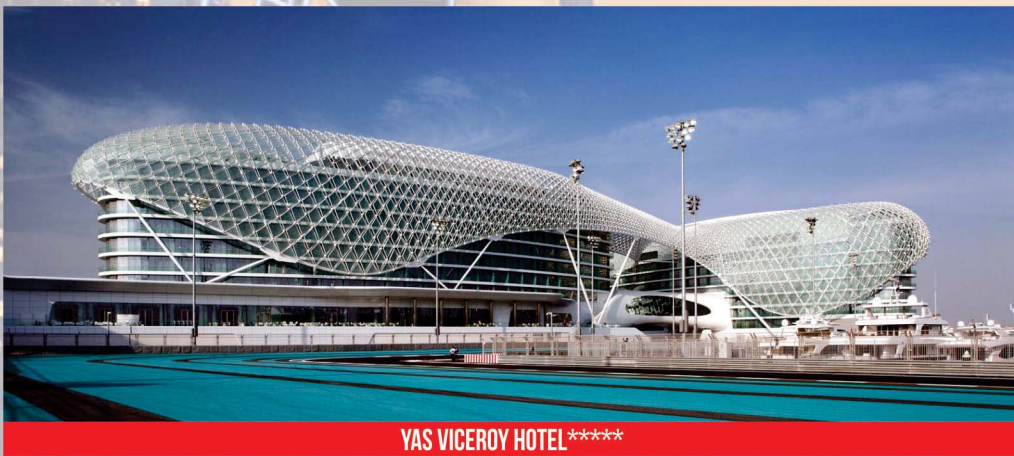

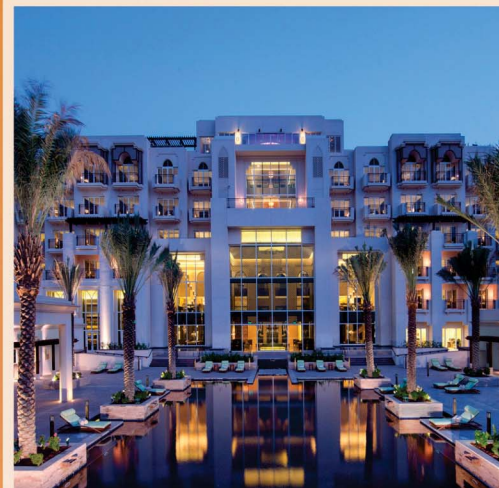

ABOUT OMAN:

Oman is an Arab state in south west Asia on the southeast coast of the Arabian peninsula. It has a strategically important position at the mouth of the Persian Gulf. It is bordered by the UAE to the northwest, Saudi Arabia to the west, and Yemen to the southwest and also shares a marine border with Iran. Oman is an absolute monarchy in which the Sultan of Oman exercises ultimate authority, but its parliament has some legislative and oversight powers. Oman is a member of Gulf Cooperation Council, United Nations, Organization of Islamic Cooperation and Arab League. It has long standing military and political ties with the United Kingdom and the United States.

HISTORY:

Aybut Al Auwal in the Dhofar region of Oman a site was discovered in 2011 containing more than 100 surface scatters of stone tools belonging to a regionally-specific African lithic industry - the late Nubian Complex - known previously only from the northeast and Horn of Africa. Two optically stimulated luminescence age estimates place the Arabian Nubian Complex at 106,000 years old. This supports the proposition that early human populations moved from

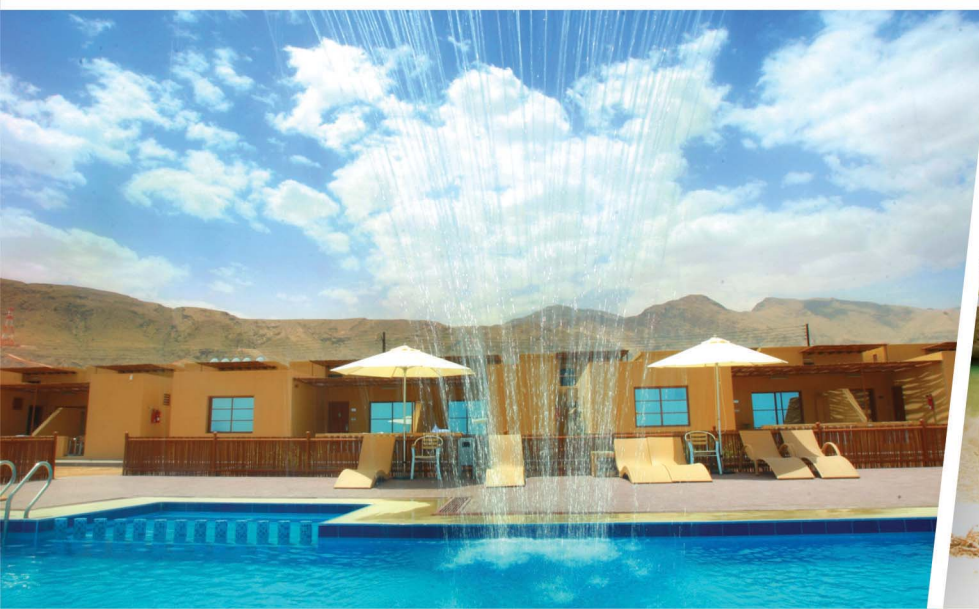
Africa into Arabia during the Late Pleistocene. On a mountain rock-face in the same district, animal drawings have been discovered. Similar drawings have also been found in the Wadi Sahtan and Wadi Bani Kharus areas of Rustaq, consisting of human figures carrying weapons and being confronted by wild animals. Siwan in Haima is another Stone Age location and some of the archaeologists have found arrowheads, knives, chisels and circular stones which may have been used to hunt animals. Omanis were among the first people to come in contact with and accept Islam. The conversion of the Omanis is usually ascribed to Amr ibn al-As, who was sent by Muhammad around 630 AD to invite Jayfar and 'Abd, the joint rulers of Oman at that time, to accept the faith. In submitting to Islam, Oman became an Ibadhi state, ruled by an elected leader, the Imam. Sultan Qaboos opened up the country, embarked on Economic reforms and followed a policy of modernization by spending on health, education and welfare. In 1981 Oman became a founding member of the Six Nation Gulf Cooperation Council.

ABOUT MUSCAT

Muscat is the capital of Oman. It is also the seat of government and largest city in the Governorate of Muscat. As of 2010 census, the population of the Muscat metropolitan area was 734,697. The metropolitan area spans approximately 1500 K.M.2 and includes six provinces called Wilayats. A regional military power in the 18th century, Muscat's influence extended as far as East Africa & Zanzibar. Muscat attracted foreign tradesman & settlers such as the Persians, the Balochis & Gujaratis. The rocky western Al Hajar mountains dominate the landscape of Muscat. The city lies on the proximity of the strategic straits of Hormuz. The origin of the word Muscat is disputed. The sleepy old town of Muscat clinging to a small natural harbour & its old port of Muttrah in the neighbouring bay are just fragments of modern Muscat. Since the 1970s the city

has blossomed with the help of Oil money, and new business & office districts have sprouted in all directions.

AL ALAM PALACE:

Al Alam Palace is the ceremonial palace of his Majesty Sultan Qaboos of Oman located in Muscat. The palace has a history of over 200 years, built by Imam Sultan Bin Ahmed the 7th direct grandfather of the current sultan. The existing palace, which has a facade of gold & blue was rebuilt as a royal residence in 1972.

OMANI FRENCH MUSEUM:

The Omani French Museum is a heritage museum, located in the former residence of the French Consul, Bait Faransa on lane 9310 Qasr Al Alam Street, in the old quarter of Muscat. The white building which was essentially a palace was initially established as a present by the Sultan Assayed to the French Consul in Muscat in 1896.



MUSCAT

MUTTRAH SOUQ:

Al Dhalam Souq is the local name for the Muttrah Souq. The Muttrah souq is perhaps one of the oldest market places in the Arab world because Muscat is the world's largest natural harbor and has seen immense trade in the age of sail, being strategically located on the way to India and China. It has been named after darkness because of the crowded stalls and lanes where the sunrays do not infiltrate during the day and the shopper's needs lamps to know their destination.

SULTAN QABOOS GRAND MOSQUE:

The Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque is the main Mosque in the Sultanate of Oman. In 1992 Sultan Qaboos directed that his country of Oman should have a Grand Mosque. A competition for its design took place in 1993 and after a site was chosen at Bausher, construction commenced in 1995. The mosque is built from 300,000 tons of Indian sandstone. The main prayer hall is square with a central dome rising to a height of fifty metres above the floor. The main prayer hall can hold over 6500 worshippers, while the women's prayer hall can accommodate 750 worshippers. A major feature of the design of the interior is the prayer carpet which covers the floor of the prayer hall. It contains, 1,700,000,000 knots, weights 21 tones and took four years to produce, and brings together the classical tabriz, Kasahan & Isfahan design traditions.



ROYAL OPERA HOUSE:

The royal opera house is Oman's premier venue for Musical arts and culture. The opera house is located in Shati Al Qurm district of Muscat. The royal opera house reflects contemporary Omani architecture and has a capacity to accommodate maximum of 1100 people. The opera house complex consists of a theater, auditorium, formal landscaped gardens, and cultural market with retail, luxury restaurants and an art centre for musical, theatrical and operatic productions. In march 2013 Indian Violin icon Dr. L. Subramanyam performed at the opera house and described it as the only orchestra in the Middle East composed entirely of musicians from the region.

THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF OMAN:

The National Museum of Oman, formerly known as the Museum of Bait Assayed / Nadir bin Faisal bin Turki, is a national museum, located off A'Noor Street in Ruwi, Oman. Established in 1978, the museum contains silver ornaments, copper crafts and displays Omani ships. The museum has a section dedicated to the belongings of Al Busaidi dynasty, and the rulers of Zanzibar. The museum also has a highly important 8th century letter by the Prophet Mohammed to the rulers of Oman spreading the Islamic faith to the country.





SUR

SUR:

Sur is a capital city of Ash Sharqiyah Region, northeastern Oman, on the coast of the Gulf of Oman. It is located 93 miles (150 km) southeast of the Omani capital Muscat. Historically the city is known for being an important destination point for sailors. Today the sea still plays an important part in the life of Sur.

RAS AL HADD:

The jutting headland known as Ras Al Hadd is the first point in Arabia touched by the rising sun. one of the world's largest concentrations of green turtles nests on the 40 K.M. coastline.

WAHIBA SANDS:

The Wahiba Sands is a region of desert in Oman. The region is named after the Wahiba tribe. The area is

defined by a boundary of 180 kilometers north to south and 80 kilometers east to west, with an area of 12,500 square kilometers (4,800 sq mi). The desert has been of scientific interest since a 1986 expedition by the Royal Geographical Society documented the diversity of the terrain, the flora and fauna, noting 16,000 invertebrates as well as 200 species of other wildlife, including avifauna. They also documented 150 species of native flora.

WADI SHAB & WADI TIWI:

Wadi Shab lies in Niyabat Tiwi, Wilayat of Sur, is 76 km from Qurayyat. It is easy to reach this wadi from the Qurayyat-Sur highway. The wadi combines the attractions of coast areas and inland wonders. It has at least seven pools of shimmering emerald green water

studded beautiful boulders. One of the pools is in a cave where light streams in dramatically from above and there are fantastic echoes as you swim and splash.

WADI BANI KHALID

Wadi Bani Khalid is a wadi about 203 km from Muscat, Oman. It is the best-known wadi of the Sharqiyah region. Its stream maintains a constant flow of water throughout the year. Large pools of water and boulders are scattered along the course of the wadi. As a geographical area, Wadi Bani Khalid covers a large swathe of low land and mountains. Caves form some of the interesting features of this wadi. These include Kahf Maqal which is one of the Sultanate's underground chambers.

MUSANDAM

MUSANDAM PENINSULA:

The Musandam Peninsula, the mountainous northern tip of southeast Arabia, is separated from the rest of Oman part of the UAE towards Iran, with which it has traded for centuries. It creates the construction at the lanes in the world. Until the 1990s the peninsula was a strictly military zone. Musandam has been subject to faulting and in the past 10,000 years has been forced downwards resulting in many drowned valleys. These spectacular slash like fjords in the cliffs account for its incredibly long 600 k.m. coastline. The highest summit in the peninsula, Jebel Harim peaks at 2087 metres above sea level.

KHASAB:

Khasab is a city in an exclave of Oman bordering the United Arab Emirates. It is the local capital of the Musandam peninsula and is dubbed the "Norway of Arabia".

KHASAB CASTLE:

This small museum is definitely worth a look. In various rooms around the fort's corner towers and walls, there are exhibits of traditional Musandam lifestyle and artifacts. These are explained with well-designed posters and showcases in the round tower in the courtyard; the region's archaeology and natural history is also mentioned. Three examples of locally made boats, as well as replicas of traditional Musandam houses, are in the courtyard.



SALALAH

SALALAH:

Salalah is the capital and seat of the governor or Wali of the southern Omani province of Dhofar. The population of Salalah was 197,169 in 2009. Salalah is the second largest city in the Sultanate of Oman, and the largest city in the Dhofar Province. Salalah is the birthplace of the Sultan, Qaboos bin Said.

AL BALID ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE:

Al Balid Archaeological Site on the Salalah waterfront is a new model for archaeological tourism with guided site tours, a museum, gift shop and coffee shop. A UNESCO World Cultural and Heritage listed archaeological site, Al Baleed was a settlement during the Iron Age. The Land of Frankincense Museum can be seen on the right. Go back in time at the Al Baleed Archaeological Park and Museum. Al Baleed's history goes back to pre-Islamic times when there was a large Iron Age settlement in the same location. The city of Baleed itself was founded in the 11th century AD and rapidly became a centre of commerce for the frankincense trade. Today, visitors can explore the remains of a grand mosque, citadel and the old city wall and gates. As the historic remains are set in a picturesque nature reserve, it's an ideal place to relax, enjoy bird watching or take a boat trip.

TOMB OF NABI UMRAN:



In downtown Salalah, next to Lulu Shopping Center, is a very unusual tomb. It is the tomb of Nabi Umran, also known as Imran, who was said to be the father of Virgin Mary, which would make it a very important pilgrimage centre. But, hang on, it is also said that he may have been the father of Moses instead, or somebody good anyway. His stone sarcophagus is 33 m long, which has given rise to speculation that he may also have been a giant.

SULTAN'S PALACE

Previous sultans, including the current sultan's father, Sultan Said, lived in Salalah, but Sultan Qaboos has moved to Muscat. He still uses the Sultan's Palace in Salalah as his summer residence. The palace, known as Al Husn, was originally built by Sultan Turki in the nineteenth century, but has been extended by successive sultans, and it is now a big, modern complex

of buildings, overlooking the beach, south of the city centre. It is surrounded on the landward side by a stone wall and entered through big teak doors. The stretch of beach immediately in front of the palace is off limits to the general public, but you can get quite close and take photographs of the palace.

KHOR RORI:

Khor Rori is an Early South Arabian archaeological site near Salalah in the Dhofar region of modern Oman. The small fortified town was founded as an outpost for the kingdom of Aadramawt around the 1st century CE, but the site shows signs of hadramite settlement back to the 2nd century BCE. The settlement was probably abandoned in the seventh century. It was inscribed in 2000, along with other sites along the Incense Route in Oman, as part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Land of Frankincense

MIRBAT:

Mirbat is a coastal town in the Dhofar governorate, in southwestern Oman. It was the site of the 1972 Battle of Mirbat between Communist guerrillas on one side and the Armed forces of the Sultan of Oman and their Special Air Service advisers. Ash Shihr was involved in the export of frankincense in ancient times, to be traded as far as China.

JABAL SAMHAN NATURE RESERVE:

Jabal Samhan Nature Reserve is a nature reserve in Dhofar, Oman. It has an area of 4,500 square kilometres (1,700 sq mi) and has no permanent population. It is one of the last places with wild Arabian leopards.

WADI DARBAT:

Wadi Darbat is a natural park with majestic views of waterfalls, lakes, mountains, caves, wildlife and lush green vegetation. There is a 100 meter waterfall and many cave chambers with old stalactites and stalagmites. The caves were used by the shepherds as shelter and one can see colored paintings of animals on the cave walls. At the end of the Wadi, there is a cave which is considered to be the largest natural cave in Oman.



NIZWA

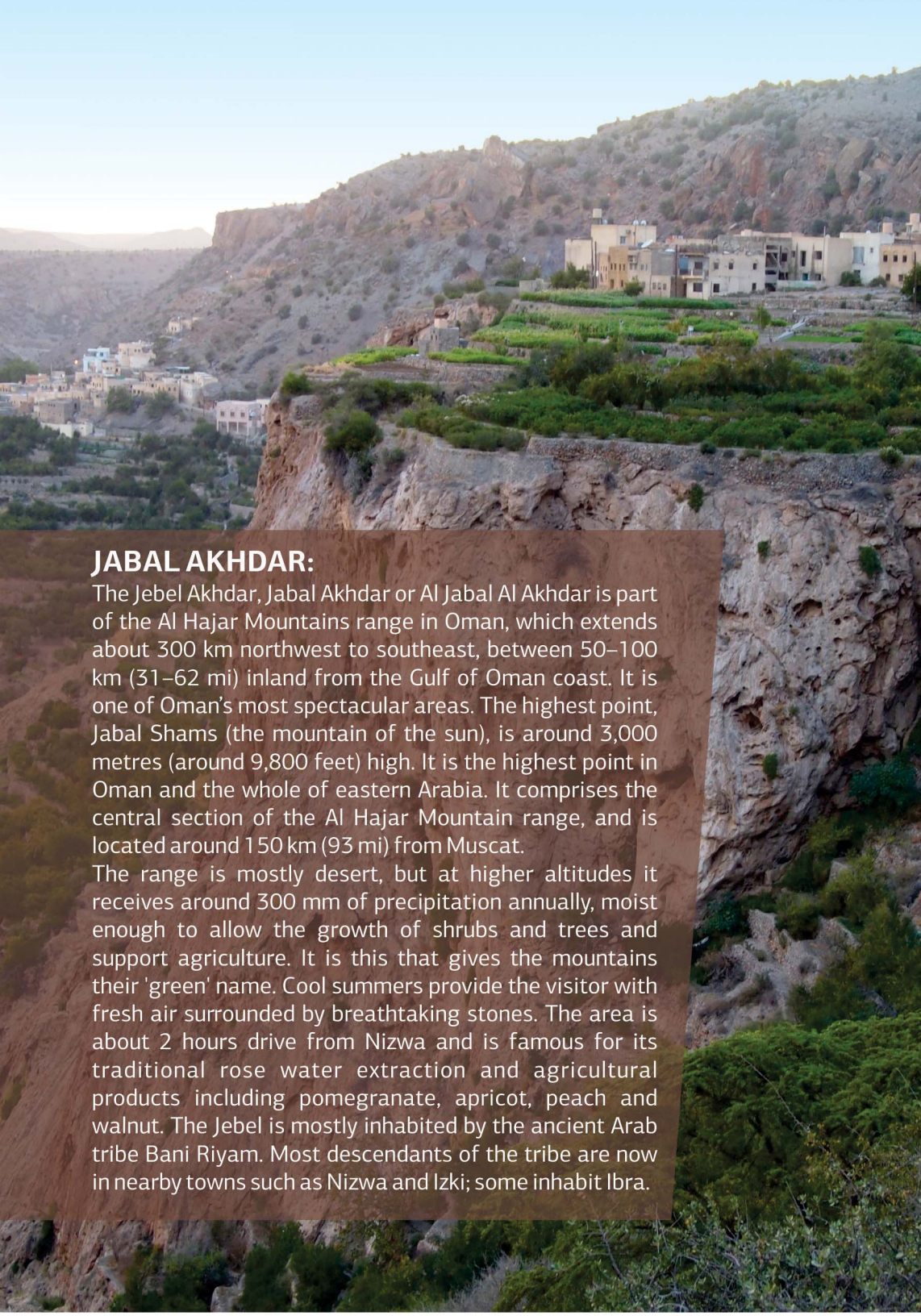
NIZWA

Nizwa is the largest city in the Ad Dakhiliyah Region in Oman and was the capital of Oman proper. Nizwa is about 140 km (1.5 hours) from Muscat. The population is estimated at around 700,000 people including the two areas of Burkat Al Mooz and Al Jabel Al Akhdar. Nizwa is one of the oldest cities in Oman and it was once a center of trade, religion, education and art. Its Jama (grand mosque) was formerly a center for Islamic learning. Nizwa acquired its importance because it has been an important meeting point at the base of the Western Hajar Mountains.

NIZWA SOUQ:

The city, famous for its handicrafts and agricultural products, has an expansive souq with an array of products. It is one of the most important in the country besides Muttrah. The souq bustles with vendors selling everything from meat, fish, fruits and vegetables to spices, dates, gold and silverware. Nizwa is renowned for its silver jewelry which is considered to be the best in the country. Its people are masters in Khanjar making (curved dagger), recognised for its distinctive style and patterns. They also make copper ware, coffee pots, swords, leather goods and pottery.





JABAL AKHDAR:

The Jebel Akhdar, Jabal Akhdar or Al Jabal Al Akhdar is part of the Al Hajar Mountains range in Oman, which extends about 300 km northwest to southeast, between 50–100 km (31–62 mi) inland from the Gulf of Oman coast. It is one of Oman's most spectacular areas. The highest point, Jabal Shams (the mountain of the sun), is around 3,000 metres (around 9,800 feet) high. It is the highest point in Oman and the whole of eastern Arabia. It comprises the central section of the Al Hajar Mountain range, and is located around 150 km (93 mi) from Muscat.

The range is mostly desert, but at higher altitudes it receives around 300 mm of precipitation annually, moist enough to allow the growth of shrubs and trees and support agriculture. It is this that gives the mountains their 'green' name. Cool summers provide the visitor with fresh air surrounded by breathtaking stones. The area is about 2 hours drive from Nizwa and is famous for its traditional rose water extraction and agricultural products including pomegranate, apricot, peach and walnut. The Jebel is mostly inhabited by the ancient Arab tribe Bani Riyam. Most descendants of the tribe are now in nearby towns such as Nizwa and Izki; some inhabit Ibra.



JABAL SHAMS:

Literally, Mountain of the sun, Jabal shams is Oman's highest mountain. Known as the Grand Canton of Middle East, Jabal Shams is a must see. The canyon which has a vertical drop at 2100 meters from the summit to the base. If you wander around a little, you can see date palms and wild olives growing around the dozen small villages. It also has some of the world's oldest juniper trees, some specimens more than 100 years old.

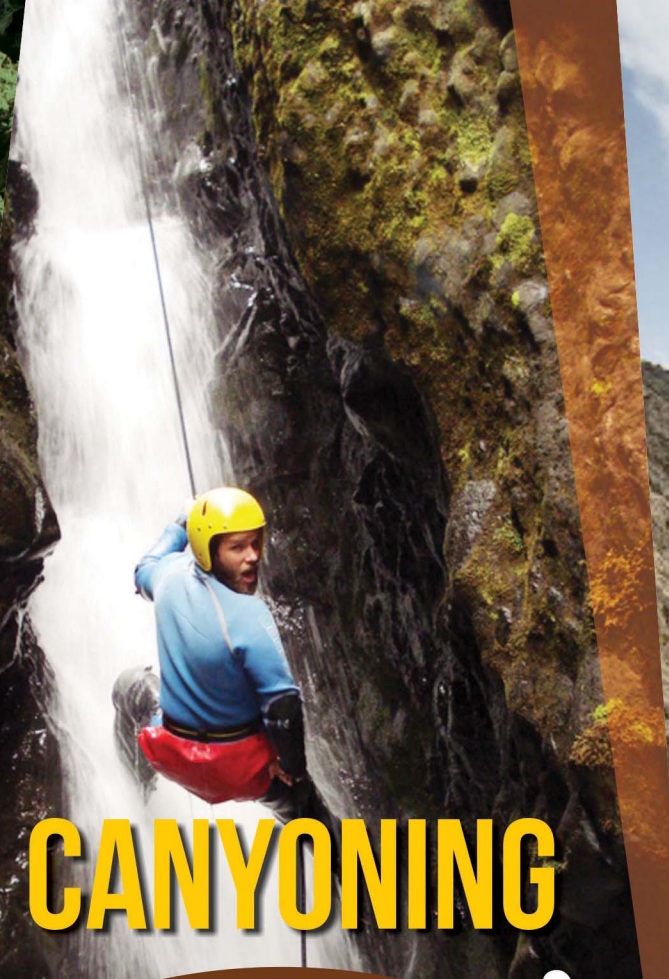

Things to do in Oman

Turtle Watching

Did you know that thousands of sea turtles migrate annually from the shores of the Arabian Gulf, the red sea and Somalia to lay their eggs on the Sultanate's shores? The best times in fact to witness this beautiful phenomenon is now. July-October is the peak time for turtle watching in Oman as approximately 20000 turtles or more lay an estimated 50000-60000 eggs each year in the Sultanate.

Muttrah Souk

Muscat lies an abundance of opportunities to explore Omani history and culture. Muttrah Souk provides insight into a way of life which has remained largely unchanged through the centuries- people still sell frankincense, silver jewellery, and Bedouin handicrafts in its many stalls.

Tawi

Nearby, the village of Tawi allows visitors to wonder at prehistoric rock paintings depicting animals and warriors dating back over 3400 years, a testimony to the long standing settlement of the region.

Bimmah Sinkhole

The Hawiyat Najm Park is in Northern Oman. Bimmah Sink hole is located in The Hawiyat Najm Park. Sinkhole are found world wide all happen due to the natural process of erosion. The water in the pool are in a unique shade of vibrant Turquoise, the pool roughly 550 meters from the sea, it is 40 meters wide and about 20 meters under the surface, there are little fish that are known to nibble people's toes.



Al Hamra

Further north, Al Hamra is an old Omani Village with a mix of ancient ruins and more modern housing. Date palms surround the township and are still fed by the traditional aflaj or canals. Al Hamra sits surrounded by desert, the green foliage of the palms standing out against the barren peaks of the mountains beyond.

Date Palm

Date Palm is a flowering plant species in the palm family *Arecaceae*, cultivated for its edible sweet fruit. The date palm is the most enduring symbol of the Sultanate's rich heritage, alongside the trusty camel, the vitalising falaj and other long cherished aspects of traditional Omani life. It has been the main wealth of people in past generations, the fruit serving as a source of daily nourishment, with the branches and the tree trunk proving valuable in the creation of a great many things that have been an integral part of the Omani home and household.
